

214s-19 Dolman Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amijin Cotton 100 [100% cotton; 137yds/125m per 1.06oz/30g skein];
 - color #1 off-white, 3 skeins [100g]
 - color #10 fresh green, 2 skeins [60g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- chest 74cm/29.13"
- center back neck-to-cuff 28cm/11.02"
- back length 41.5cm/16.34"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitches A & B: 21.5 sts and 31 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 24 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Change needle size and continue in alternating stripes of pattern stitches A and B. Refer to chart for color sequence. To shape armhole, work increases using backwards loop cast-on method.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides from marker upward using mattress stitch. Seam sleeve undersides with whipstitch. Pick up stitches around cuff and neckline, respectively, and work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.


Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times


Back




Front




Color sequence




Pattern stitch A




Pattern stitch B
