

214w-02 Long Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino [100% merino; 104yds/95m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
 - medium:
 - color #1 ivory, 9 skeins [330g]
 - color #11 gray, 9 skeins [330g]
 - large:
 - color #1 ivory, 10 skeins [370g]
 - color #11 gray, 10 skeins [370g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) and 5.7mm (approx. US 9) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (30mm/1.18")

Finished measurements:

- medium:
 - bust 96cm/37.80"
 - cross back width 35.5cm/13.98"
 - back length 70cm/27.56"
 - sleeve length 52.5cm/20.67"
- large:
 - bust 106cm/41.73"
 - cross back width 40.5cm/15.94"
 - back length 72cm/28.35"
 - sleeve length 53.5cm/21.07"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 13.5 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of color 1 and one strand of color 11).

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch. Reverse shaping of right front for left front.

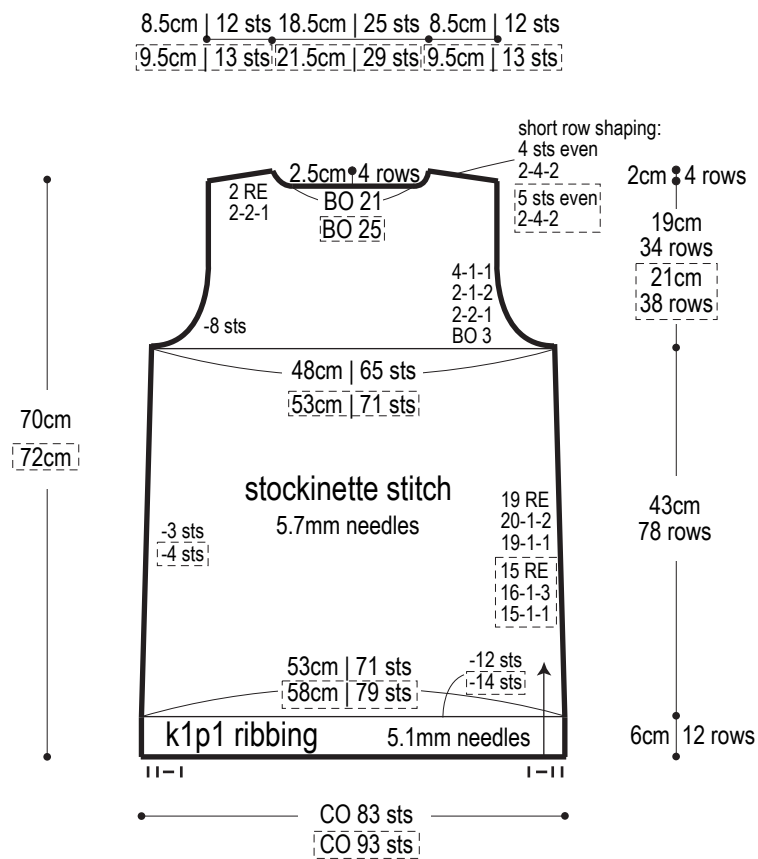
Pockets: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch and k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Seam to front where indicated.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around front edges and neckline; work edging in k1p1 ribbing using double-pointed needles (DPNs) since there are so many stitches. Be sure to work buttonholes in right front edging. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

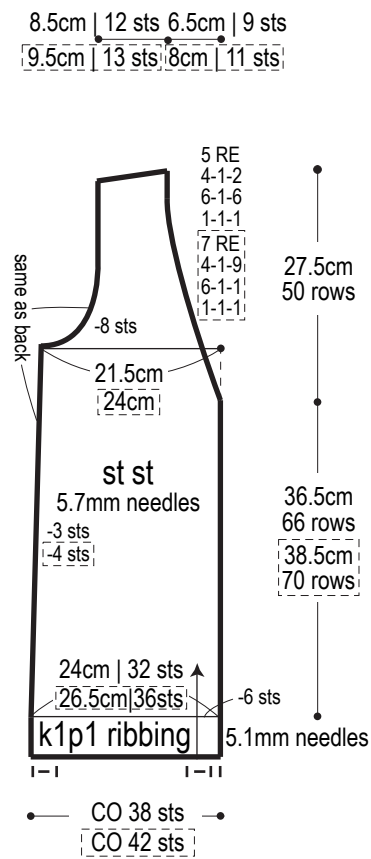
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette stitch # # # = rows-stitches-times

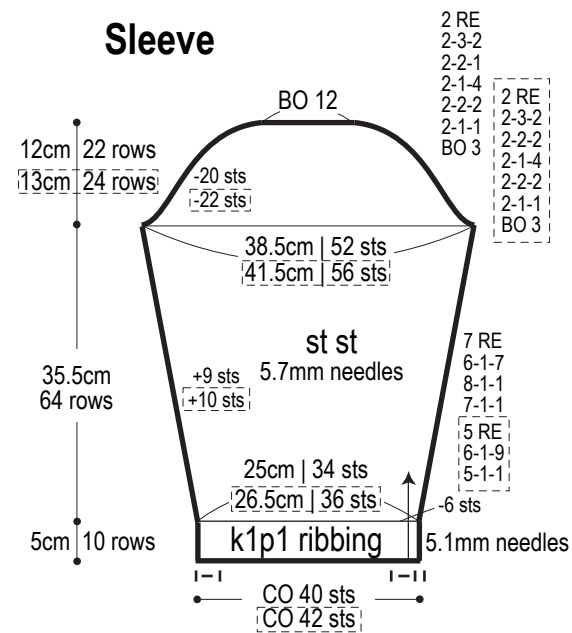


Right front

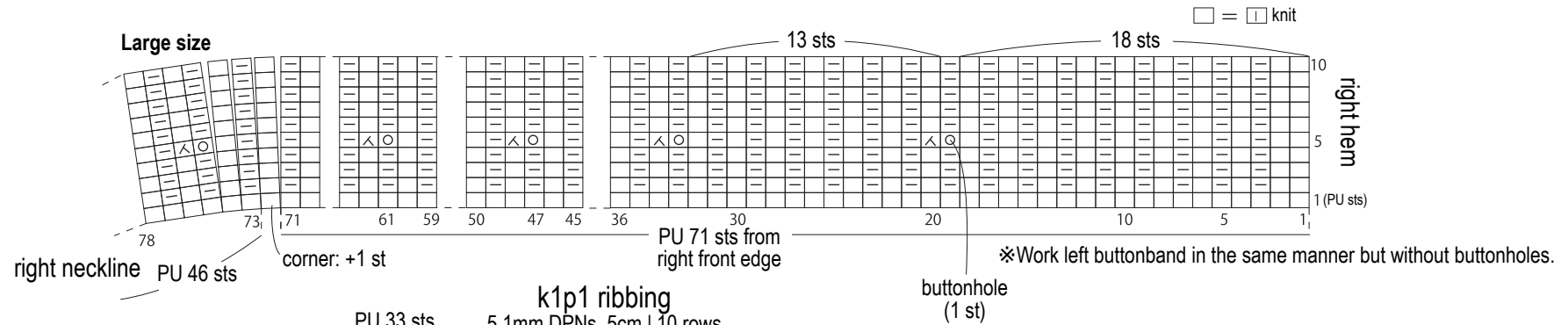
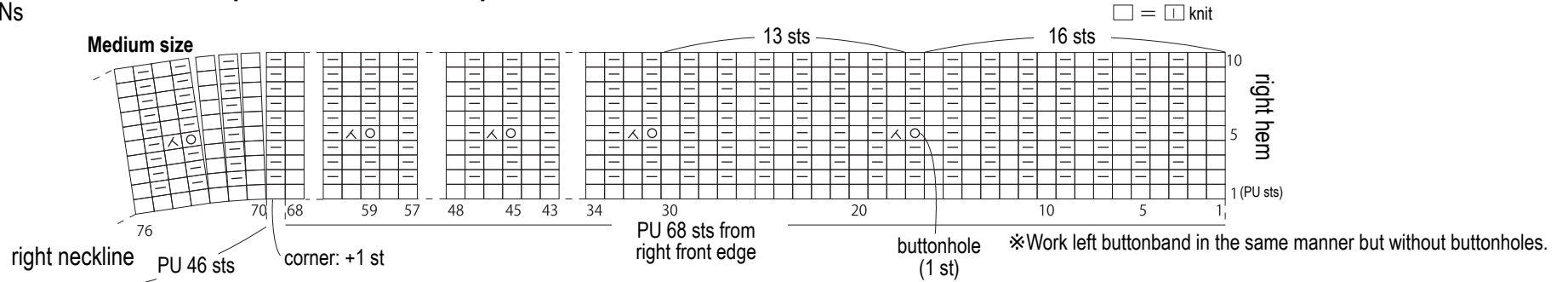


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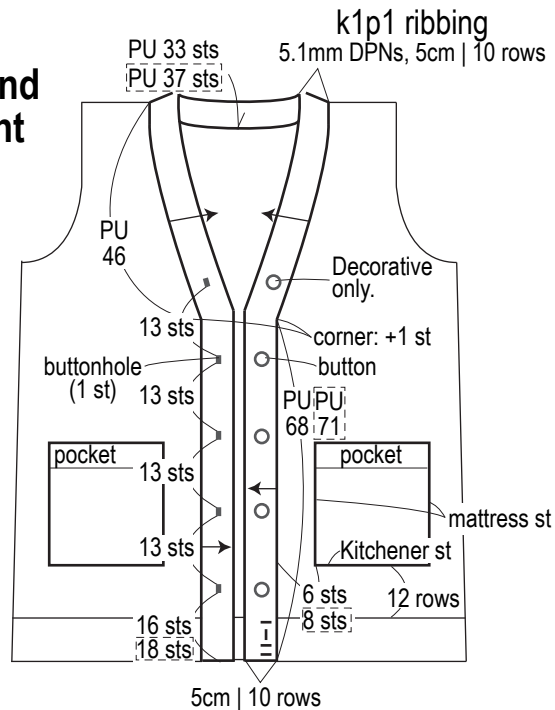
Where only one set of numbers is given, it refers to both sizes.

5.1mm DPNs

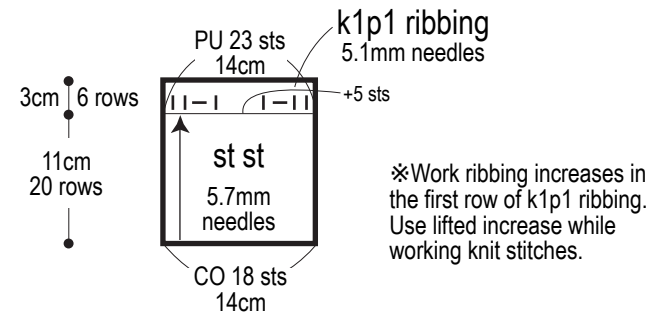


Neckline/buttonband & pocket placement



※Because you'll be working the buttonband and collar edging in one continue piece, there will be too many stitches for straight needles. Use 4 DPNs to make it easier.

Pocket (make 2)



※Work ribbing increases in the first row of k1p1 ribbing. Use lifted increase while working knit stitches.
