

214w-06 Honeycomb Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Baruffa Pura Lana 4-Ply [100% merino; 186yds/170m per 1.76oz/50g skein];
 - medium size: color #302 sand beige, 9 skeins [450g]
 - large size: color #302 sand beige, 11 skeins [520g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) and 3.3mm (approx. US 4) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 30 sts and 30 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with 3.3mm needles): 30 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

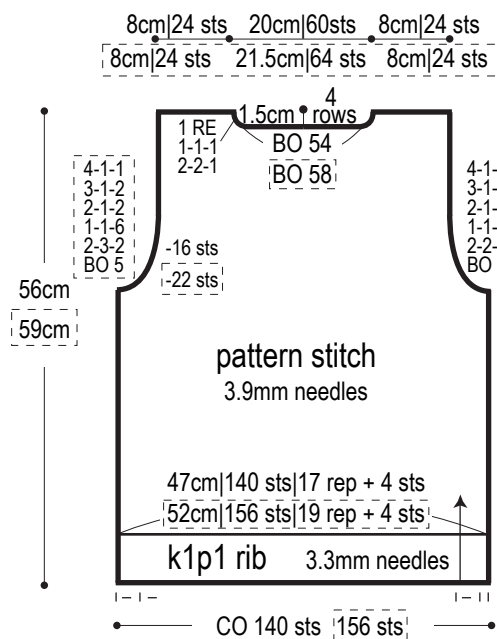
Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Change needle size, then continue in pattern stitch. Shape armscye and neckline by binding off stitches as indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from edge).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches along neckline for collar; work in k1p1 ribbing in the round according to schematic. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

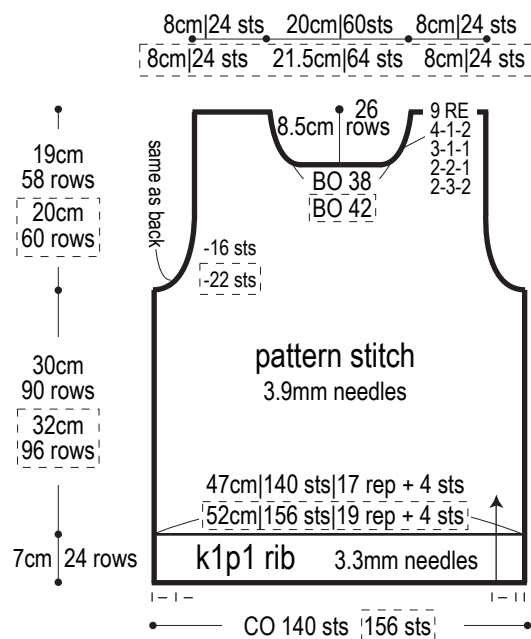
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on PU = pick up rep = pattern repeat(s) RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

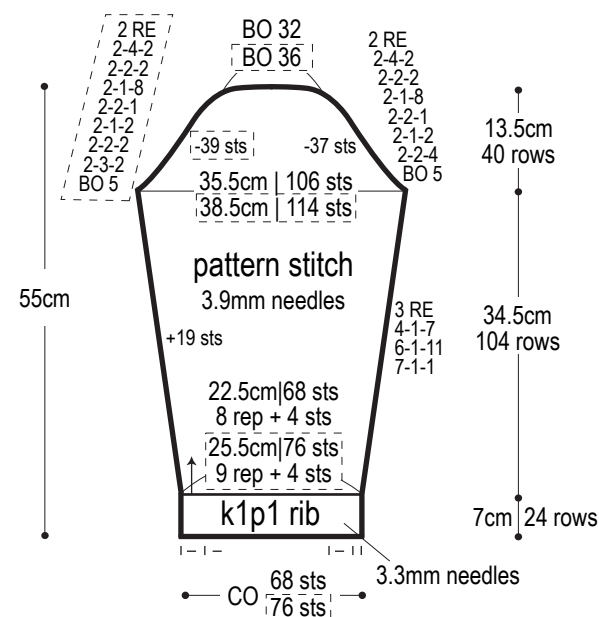
Back

Sleeve



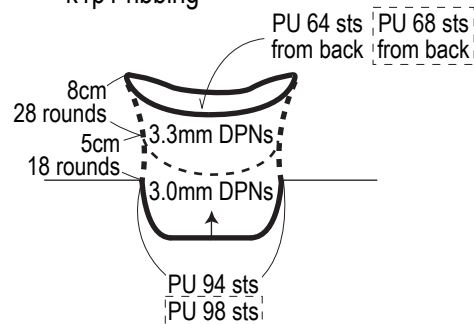
