

22-23-24 Short Jacket



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2/Pure Wool [100% wool; 79yds/72m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #4 saffron Yellow, 14 skeins [540g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6), 4.2mm (approx. US 6), and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 7 buttons (18mm/0.71")

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 58cm/22.83"
- sleeve length 54cm/21.26"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 25 sts and 25 rows
- stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body & sleeves: Cast on back and front with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch and pattern stitch according to schematic. Cast on for sleeves in the same manner, then work in reverse stockinette stitch. For decreases, either bind off stitches as indicated or work decreases at edges as indicated. For increases, use lifted increase. Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. After seaming sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch, whipstitch hem section that was folded up (on each side).

Finishing: Cast on for front buttonbands using tubular cast-on method. Bind off with tubular bind-off method, then fasten to body with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline for collar; work collar in k2p2 ribbing and then bind off with tubular bind-off method. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

k = knit

OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

p = purl

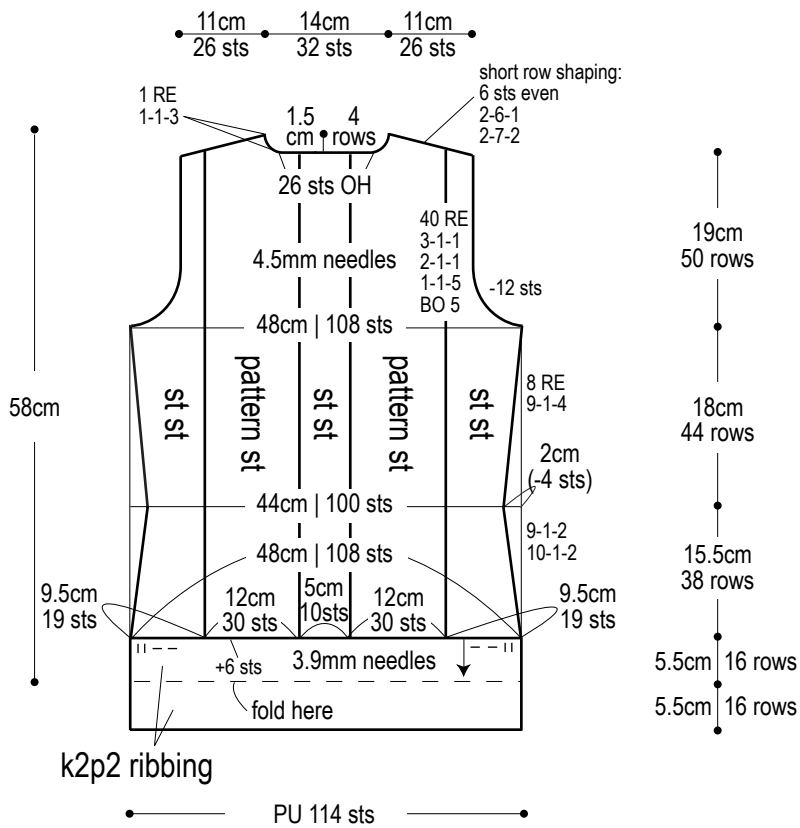
PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

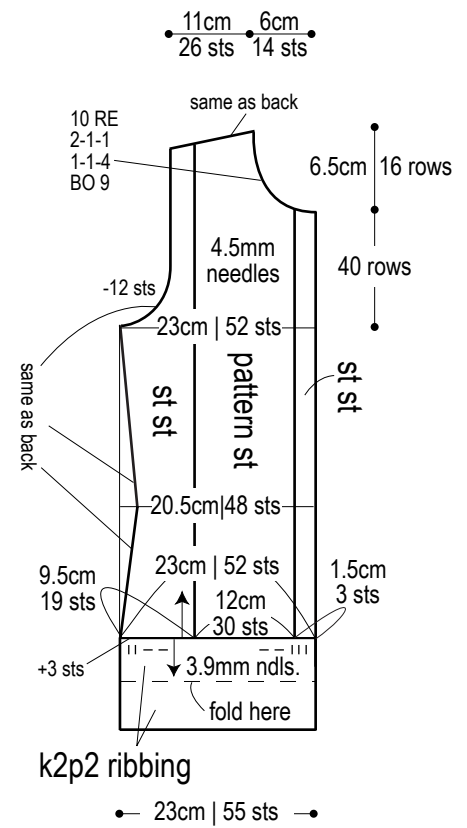
st st = stockinette stitch

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

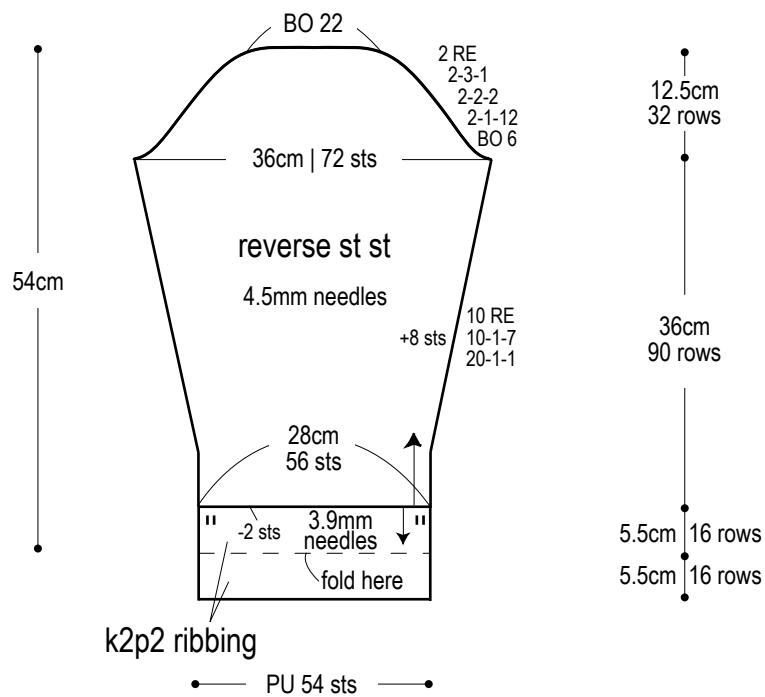
