# 27-28-209V Basic Bulky Vest



### Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Basic Bulky [100% merino; 49yds/45m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #4 gray, 10 skeins [380g]

### Tools/Notions:

• 7.0mm (no US equivalent) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

#### Finished measurements:

- chest 104cm/40.94"
- cross back width 42cm/16.54"
- back length 61cm/24.02"

#### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

stockinette stitch: 13 sts and 17 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### Summary

**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 3 rows in stockinette stitch, then 3 rows in garter sttich, then continue in stockinette stitch. Bind off 6 stitches at each armhole, then work fully fashioned edges along armholes by purling the third stitch in from the edge. (On WS, knit the third stitch in from the edge instead of purling.) For neckline/ collar, increase 1 stitch at each side of neckline using backwards loop cast-on increase. Continue working collar. Bind off loosely.

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
Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Seam sides of body and collar with mattress stitch.

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#### Abbreviations:

blco = backwards loop cast-on increase BO = bind off CO = cast on inc = increase(s) RE = row(s) even WS = wrong side #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
