

22-23-10 Mohair Tee



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Super Kid Mohair [75% mohair, 25% nylon; 306 yds./280m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #5804, 4 skeins [90g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 45cm/17.72"
- sleeve length 23cm/9.06"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 27 rows
- pattern stitch: 21 sts and 27 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch (cables) and stockinette stitch. Shape waist and sleeves (underarm seam as well as sleeve caps) by working increases or decrease 1 stitch in from the edge (refer to schematic to determine whether to increase or decrease). Shape neckline by placing stitches at the front on a stitch holder and by binding off stitches at edges as indicated.

Sleeves: Cast on as for body. Work in stockinette stitch. Remove provisional cast-on edge from hem and cuffs, respectively, picking up live stitches as you go. Work hem and cuff edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

p = purl

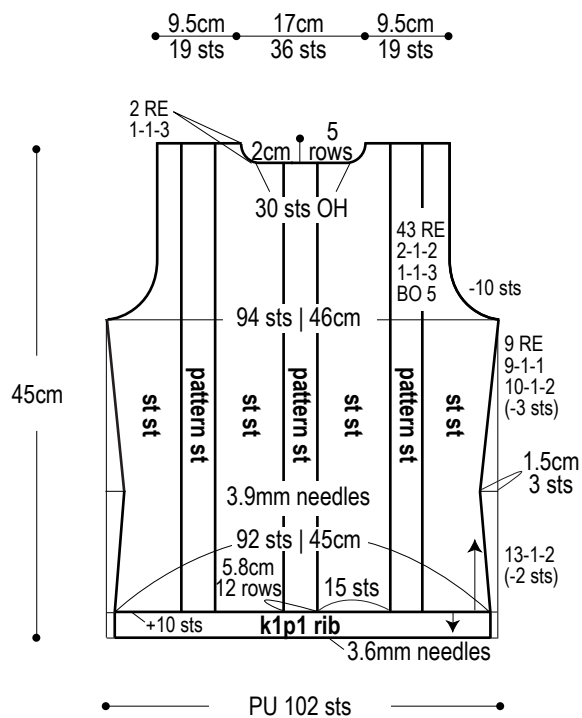
PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

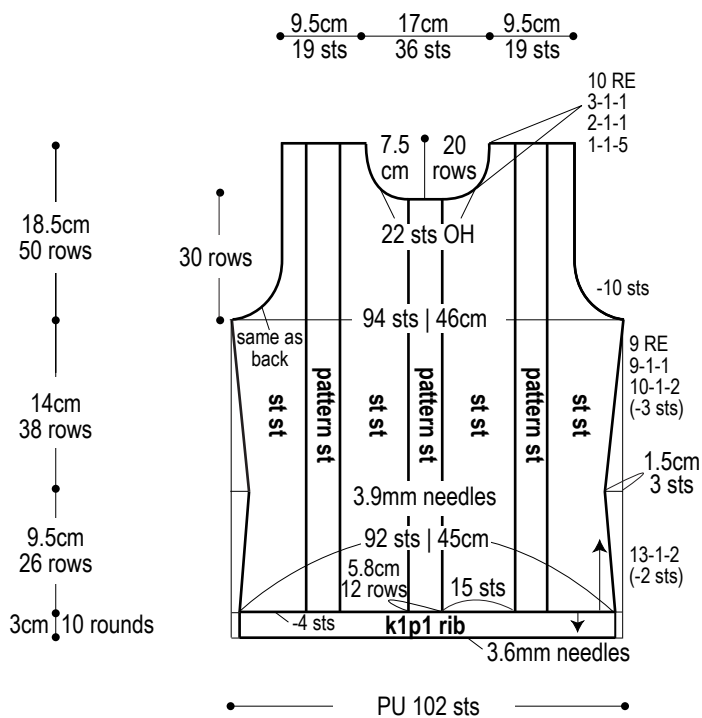
st st = stockinette stitch

= rows-stitches-times

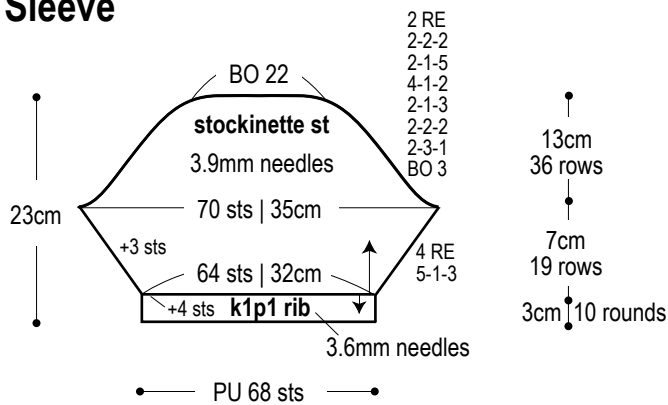

Front

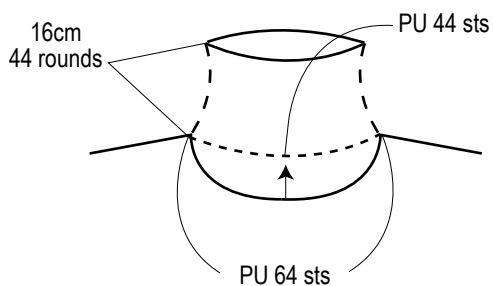


Sleeve
