

Happy Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Happy Cotton [80% cotton, 20% polyester; 151 yds/138m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #13 mustard, 5 skeins [200g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- center back neck-to-cuff 56.5cm/22.24"
- back length 49cm/19.29"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (2 stitches in from the edge).

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Seam underarm gussets with Kitchener stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Crochet edging around body (front edges, neckline, and hem) in rows, working buttonholes in right front edging only. Crochet edging around each cuff in rounds. Fasten buttons to front edging.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

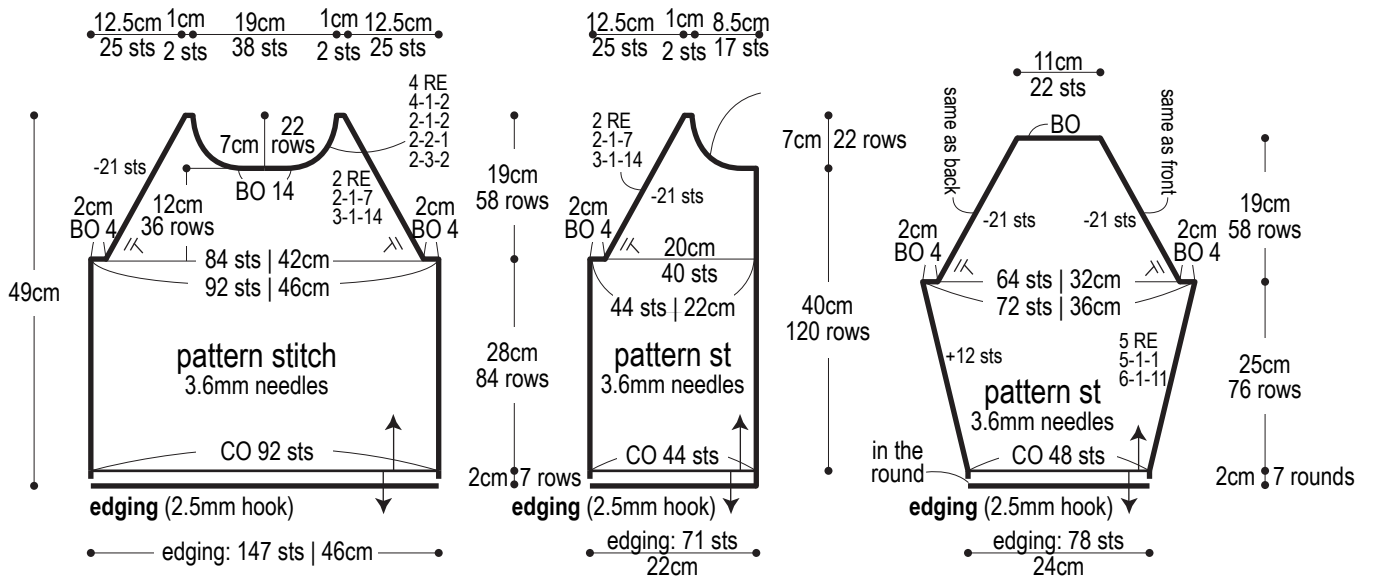
RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

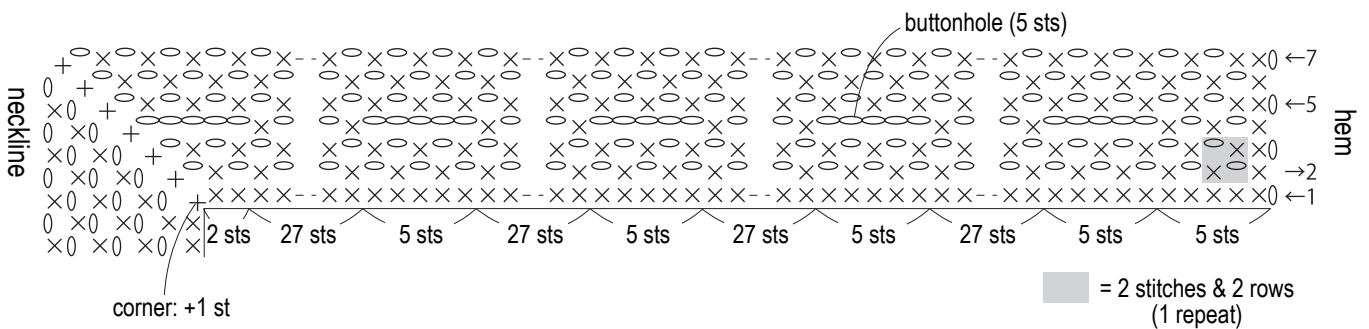
Back
