#### Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Snow Egg [97% acrylic, 3% nylon; 79yds/72m per 1.41oz/40g cone];
  - version A: color #04 light chocolate brown, 2 cones [60g]
  - version B: color #06 musk melon, 2 cones [60g]
  - version C: color #05 sugar yellow, 2 cones [60g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- zipper (20cm/7.87")
- · sewing thread

### Finished measurements:

• Please see finishing schematic.

### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 19 sts and 6 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

## **Summary**

Body of pouch: Work magic ring to begin, then ch2 for start of first round. Work in pattern stitch, increasing as indicated in chart. Work last round in sc.

**Finishing:** Fold in two where marked. On each end of folded shape, seam two stitches together with whipstitch. Sew zipper to sc stitches using half backstitch.


#### Abbreviations:

ch = chain


hdc = half double crochet (US)

m = magic ring/magic circle

sc = single crochet (US)




## **Finishing**




Insert needle into each sc st. Seam zipper to sc sts with half backstitch.

## 5-hdc special bobble stitch



Work a further 2 partial hdc sts, then pull a loop through 5 hdc sts.

Finish the bobble by pulling a loop through 2 loops on hook.



I = insert needle front to back
O = bring needle out back to front
