# Milk Pompom Casquette



#### Suggested yarn:

 Keito-Zakka Stores Milk [100% wool; 42 yds./38m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #01 milky, 8 skeins [185g]

## **Tools/Notions:**

• 5.0mm (US H) and 6.0mm (US J) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 55cm/21.65"
- depth 20cm/7.87"

# Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 17 sts and 5 rounds
- single crochet (US): 12 sts and 14 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

# **Summary**

\*Note: entire hat worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

**Top & sides:** With 5.0mm hook, work foundation chain and join into the round. Work pattern stitch in the round, increasing and decreasing where indicated. On final round (4 sts), cut yarn and thread tail through remaining stitches; cinch top of hat shut.

**Band:** Working into foundation row, with 5.0mm hook work 2 rounds of sc. When finished, do not cut yarn. Instead, put last stitch on stitch holder and retain live yarn until later.

Bill: Working into stitches indicated, work bill in sc according to chart.

**Finishing:** Using live yarn from band section, work in the round, with sc into band section and slip stitches into bill section. Make pompom and fasten to top of hat.

#### Abbreviations:

ch = chain hdc = half double crochet (US) sc = single crochet (US)
