

# Yuttari Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Le Rhone [85% ramie, 15% linen; 202 yds./185m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #02 cassis, 9 skeins [310g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 137cm/53.94"
- center back neck-to-cuff 36cm/14.17"
- back length 59.5cm/23.43"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (with 3.9mm needles): 21 sts and 27 rows
- pattern stitch (with 3.3mm needles): 24 sts and 35 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

✳️**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

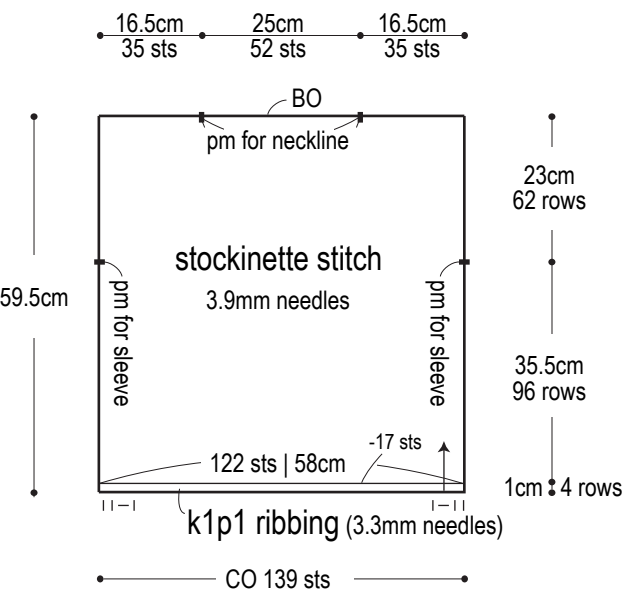
**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then in stockinette stitch. On both sides of front, shape sides by working lifted increases one stitch in from the edge. Place markers for bottom of armholes. On last row, bind off stitches for neckline between markers.

**Sleeves & finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around each cuff; work cuff edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

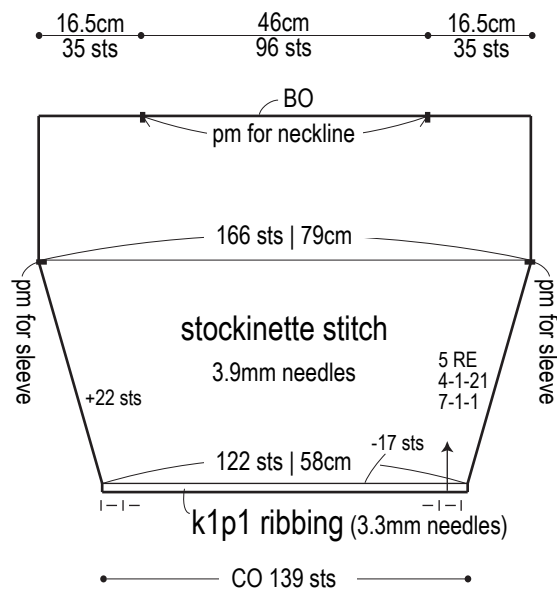
## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off  
CO = cast on  
k = knit  
p = purl  
pm = place marker  
PU = pick up  
RE = row(s) even  
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
