

215ss-01 Summer Aran



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pochette [50% merino wool, 50% cotton; 131yds/120m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
 - medium: color #02 ecru beige, 9 skeins [325g]
 - large: color #02 ecru beige, 11 skeins [440g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- medium:
 - bust 90cm/35.43"
 - center back neck-to-cuff 41cm/16.14"
 - back length 56cm/22.05"
- large:
 - bust 108cm/42.52"
 - center back neck-to-cuff 47.5cm/18.70"
 - back length 60.5cm/23.82"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A (with 3.6mm needles): 35 sts and 33 rows
- pattern stitch B (with 3.6mm needles): 27 sts and 33 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k4p4 ribbing. Continue in pattern stitches A and B. Change needle size as indicated in order to adjust gauge. Place markers for sleeves.

Sleeves: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitches A and B. Bind off. Remove provisional cast-on method, picking up live stitches as you go. Work cuff edging in k4p4 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet provisional cast-on method. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch as well, forming gathers where indicated on finishing schematic. Seam sides and sleeve undersides in one continuous mattress stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in k4p4 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit k3tog = knit 3 stitches together p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even YO = yarn over
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

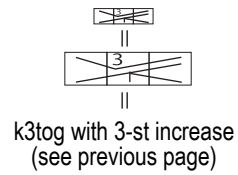
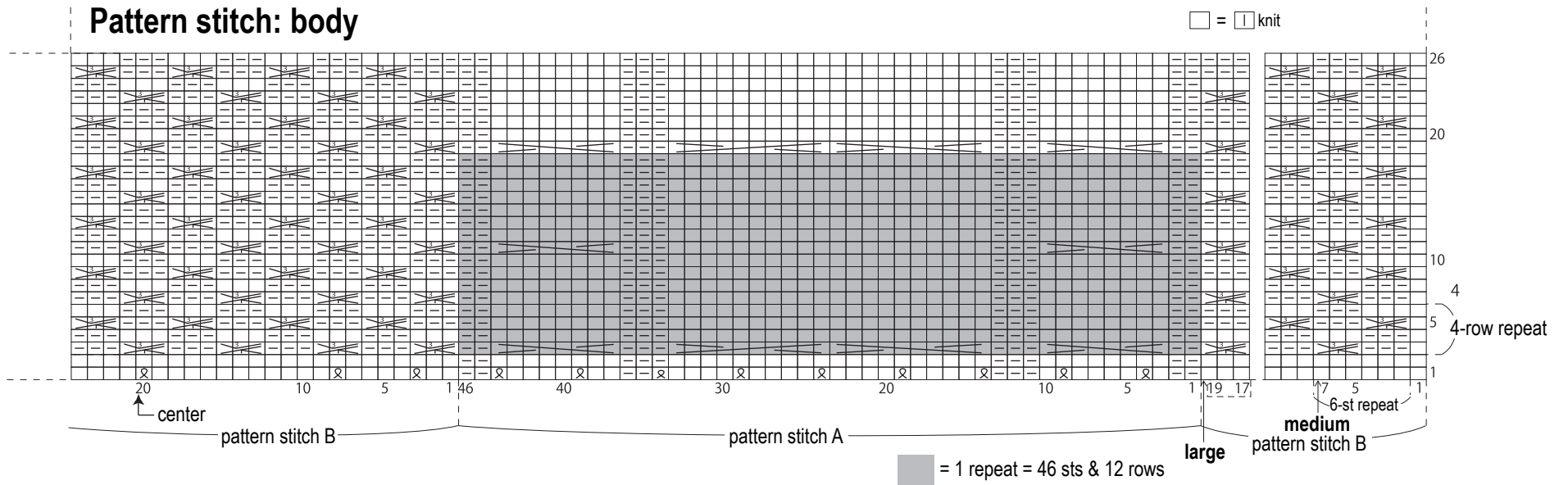
