

215ss-03 Front Cable Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Urban [100% merino wool; 394 yds./360m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - large: color #08 cloud gray, 7 skeins [260g]
 - medium: color #08 cloud gray, 6 skeins [230g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Cast on for back with crochet provisional cast-on method; work in stockinette stitch. Cast on for front in same manner, but work front in stockinette stitch and pattern stitch.

Sleeves: Cast on as for body; work in stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Remove provisional cast-on edge from bottom hem and cuffs, picking up the live stitches as you go. Work k1p1 ribbing, then bind off in pattern. Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

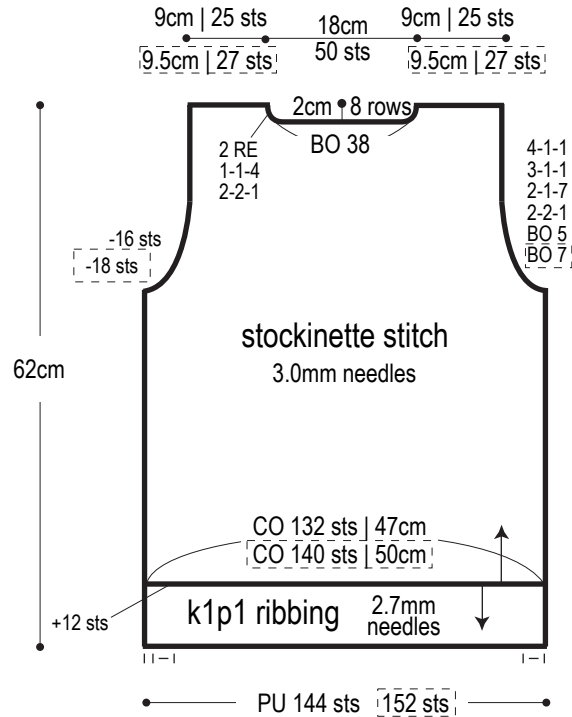
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette stitch # # # = rows-stitches-times

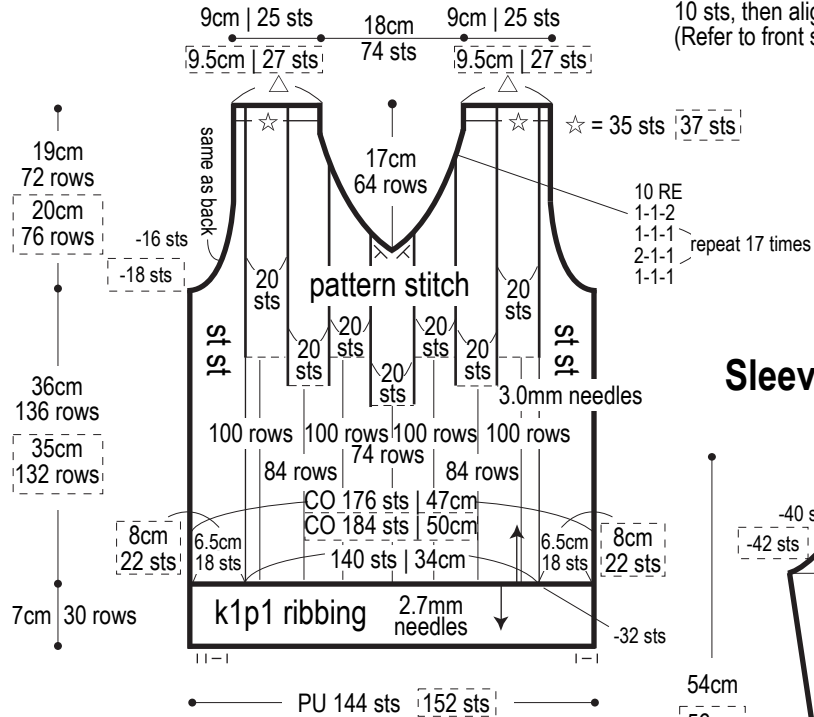

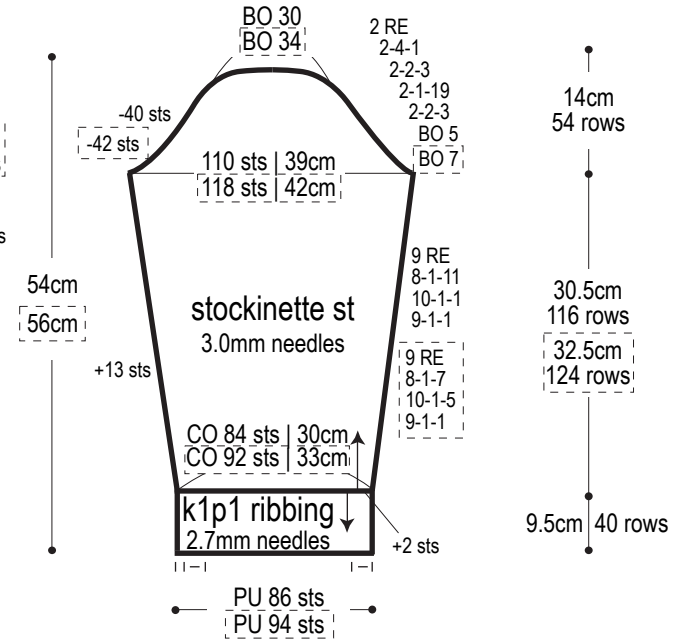


Front



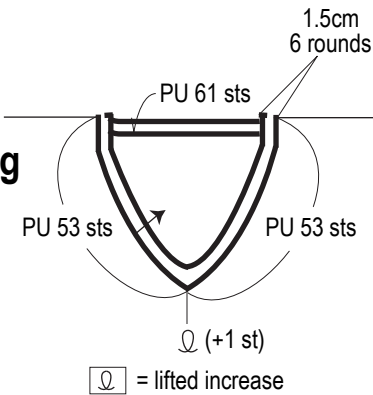
△ = on 71st [75th] row of neckline, decrease 10 sts, then align with back shoulder sts. (Refer to front schematic.)

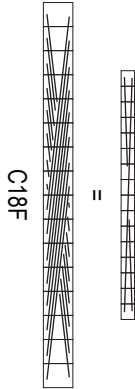


Collar: k1p1 ribbing
