

215s-12 Ravioli Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Ami Cotton Super Bulky [100% cotton; 55 yds/50m per 3.53 oz./100g hank]; color #53 vanilla, 1 hank [75g]
- Pierrot Yarns Zakka Natural Series PZA-R-3 [100% kenaf; 83 yds/76m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; natural color, 6 skeins [280g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- teknorote (polypropylene memory wire)
- fabric or wide ribbon for handles (35cm/13.78" x 50cm/19.69")
- beige sewing thread

Finished measurements:

- width 50cm/19.69"
- height 32cm/12.60"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 13 sts and 12.5 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body of bag: With kenaf yarn, work foundation chain. Work in sc in the round, working each stitch around cotton yarn (to enclose it with the kenaf yarn). Note that the rounds are worked continuously with no turning posts.

Finishing: Fold to outside at fold line; seam side sections indicated with sc worked through both layers. Continue to work sc along mouth of bag, working through just one layer. Join yarn at other end of mouth; work in sc.

✳️For both sides and mouth, work stitches around 2 strands of teknorote for stiffness.

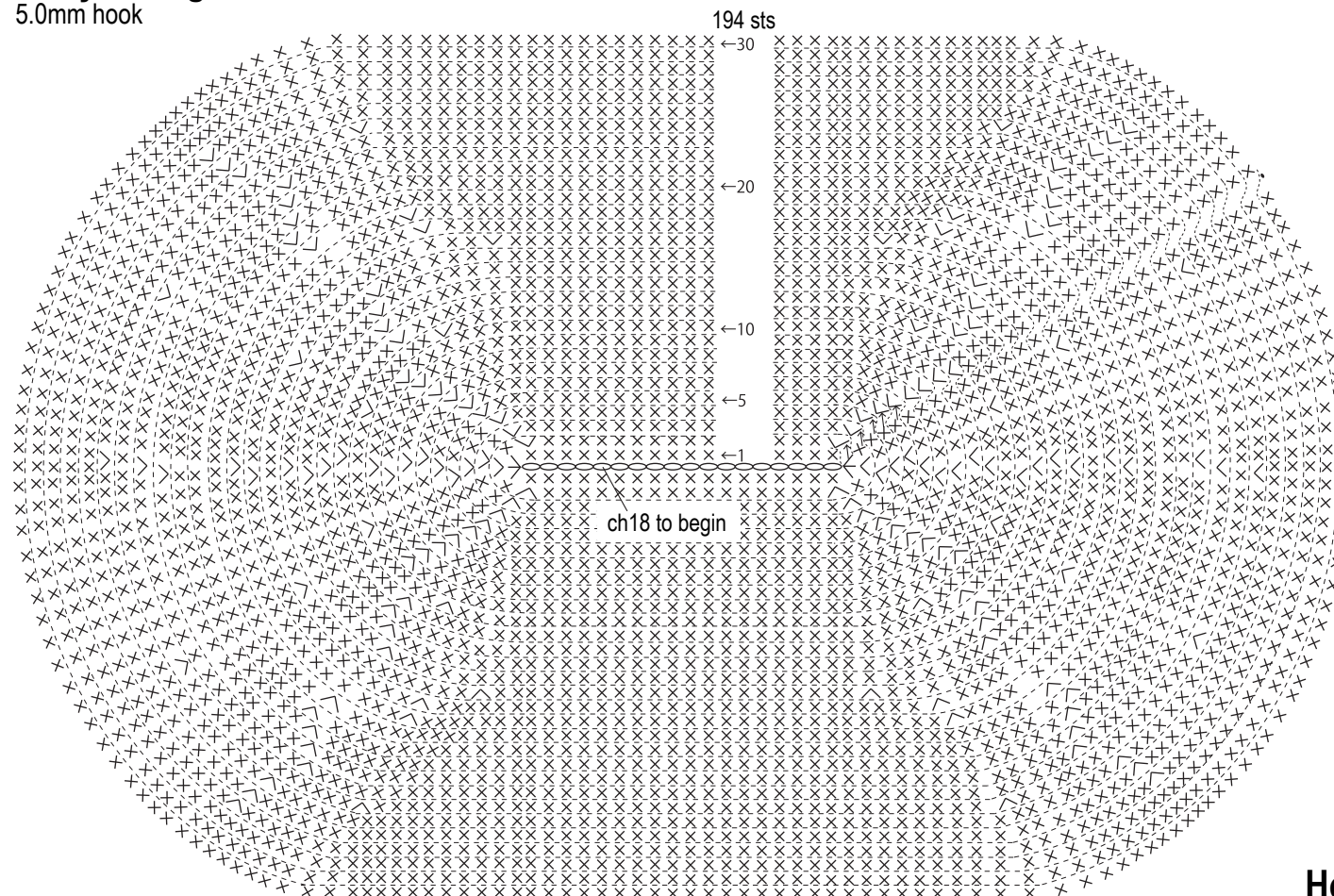
Handles: Cut fabric or ribbon to measurements indicated. Sew as indicated in schematic. Fasten to body of bag where indicated using half backstitch.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain sc = single crochet (US)

5.0mm hook



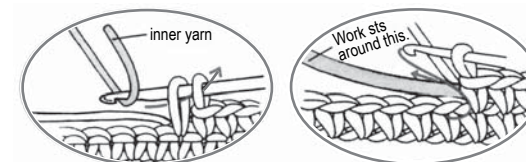

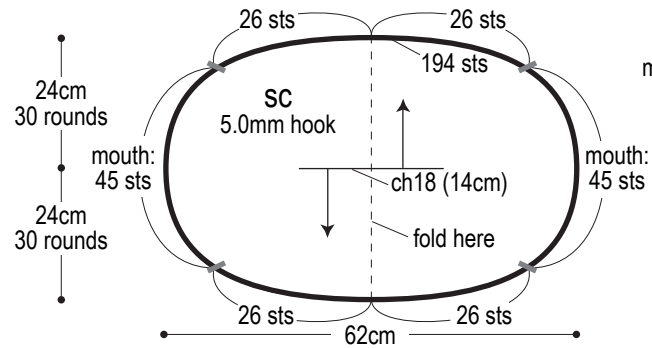

※Work in sc in kenaf, working stitches around a strand of the cotton yarn. Cotton yarn should not show through the kenaf.

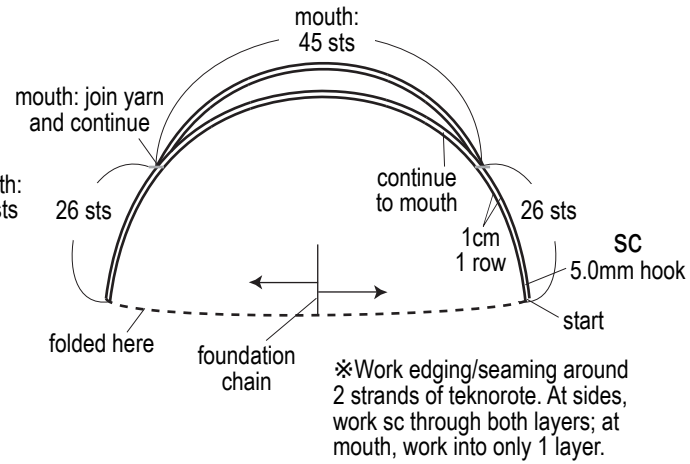
How to work one yarn around the other



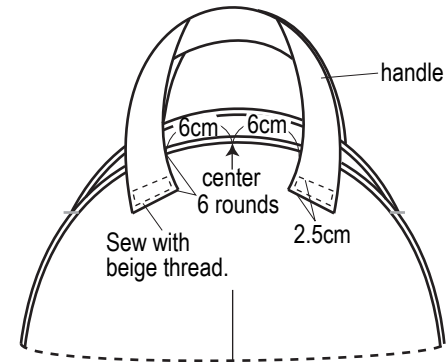
Body of bag
