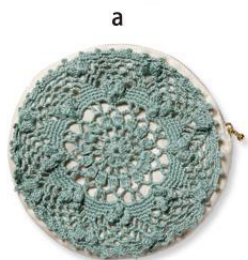


# 215ss-13 Lace Pouch

## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Milly [65% linen, 35% ramie; 112 yds/102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - version A: color #07 antique green, 1 skein [35g]
  - version B: color #03 gold yellow, 1 skein [25g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- fabric for lining: 91cm/35.83" x 25cm/9.84"
- zipper:
  - version A: 16cm/6.30"
  - version B: 20cm/7.87"

## Finished measurements:

## Gauge:

- Please refer to charts for motif sizes.

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Version A:** Work magic ring to begin, then work motif in the round according to chart. Make 2.

**Version B:** ch6 and join to work in the round. Work motif ① according to chart (make 2). Work magic ring to begin, then work motif ② in the round according to chart (make 12). Seam 6 motif ② to each motif ①.

**Finishing:** Cut lining fabric as indicated. Sew zipper to gusset piece. Seam gusset to front & back round pieces of lining with right sides facing each other (that is, inside-out). Turn lining right-side out, then sew motifs to front and back with whipstitch.

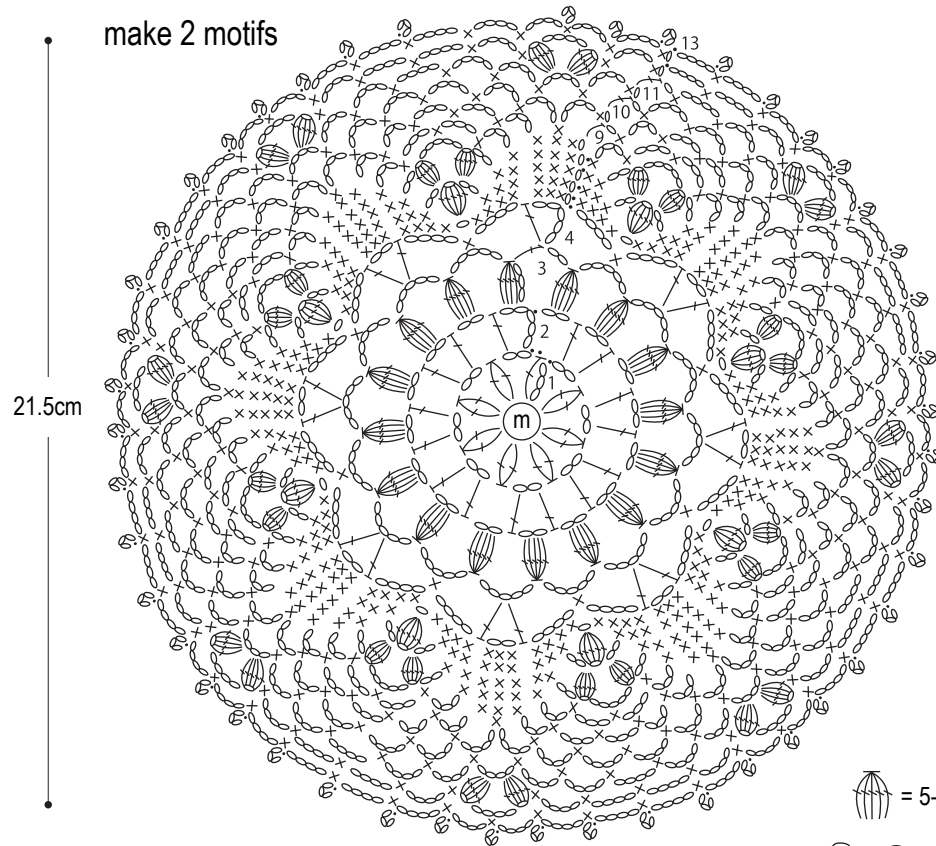
## Abbreviations:

make 2 motifs



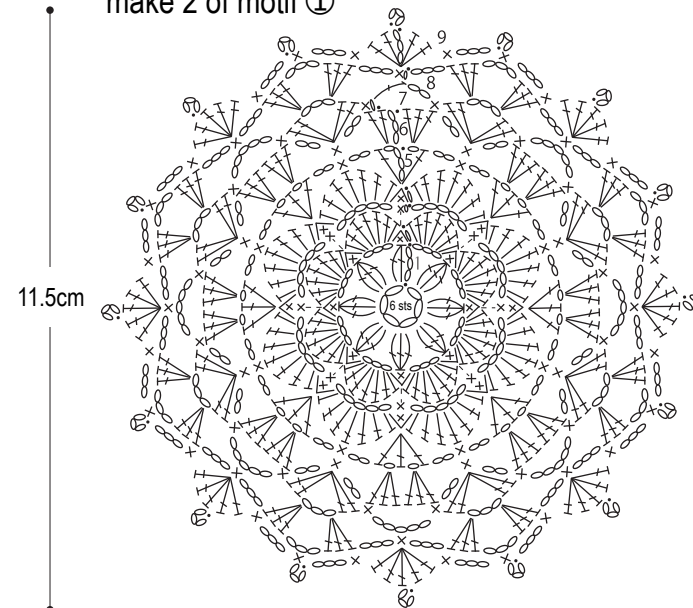
 = 5-dc cluster stitch

2.5cm



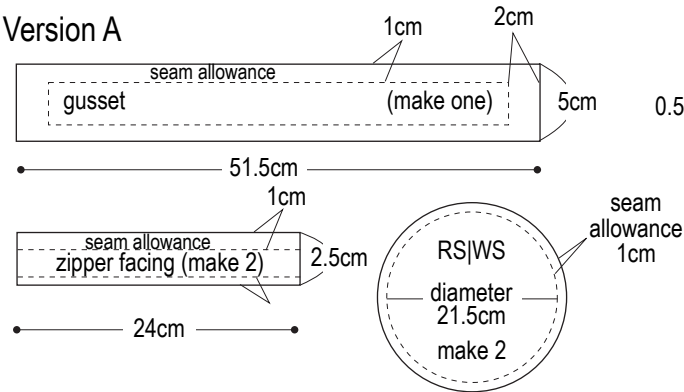
make 12 of motif ②

color #03

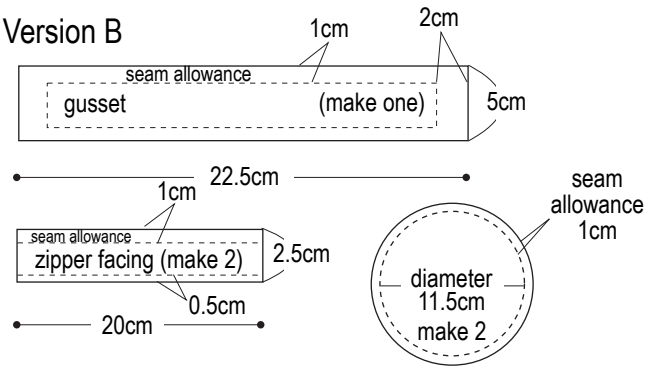

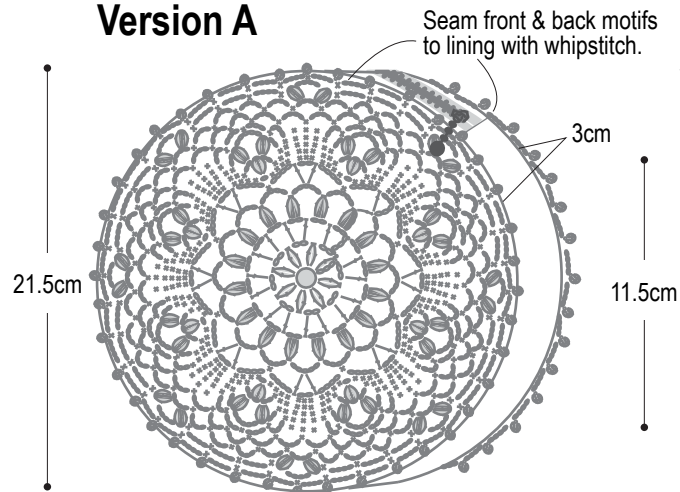

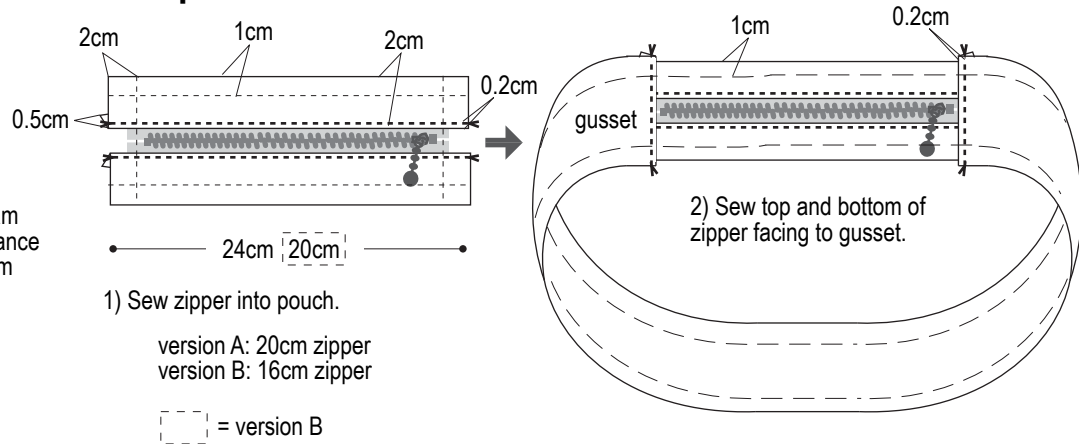
