

215s-08 Giza Top



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Silk Ramie [70% ramie, 30% silk; 514 yds/470m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #20 carrot orange, 3 cones [210g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 40cm/15.75"
- back length 51cm/20.08"
- sleeve length 29cm/11.42"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 31.5 sts and 36 rows
- garter stitch: 26 sts and 42 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on three sections (1 of section ● and 2 of section △) with long-tail cast-on method. Work 28 rows per section, increasing as indicated. Also work 28 rows for section ○. On the next row, pick up the stitches of sections △, △, and ● so that you now have one piece. Continue working in pattern stitch.

Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch, then continue in pattern stitch. Shape sleeves by working lifted increases 2 stitches in from the edge.

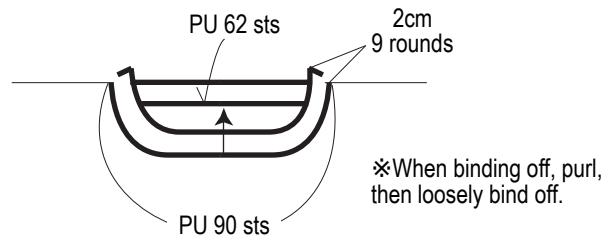
Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work edging in garter stitch and then bind off. Pick up stitches around hem; work garter stitch edging and then bind off. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam, but sew gusset stitches with stitches-to-row mattress stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side of garment).

Abbreviations:

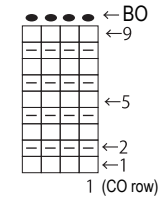
BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

2.7mm DPNs

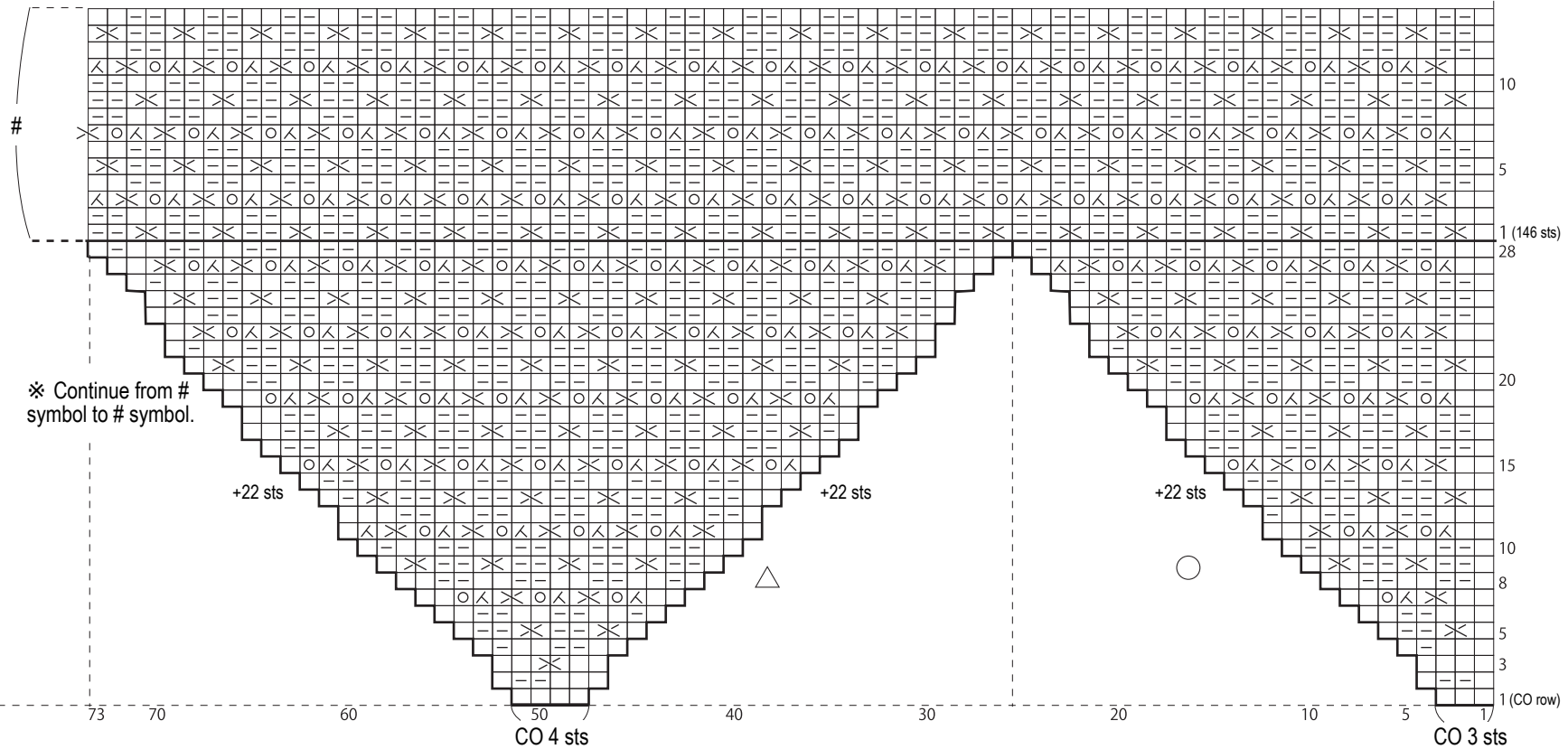


Garter stitch

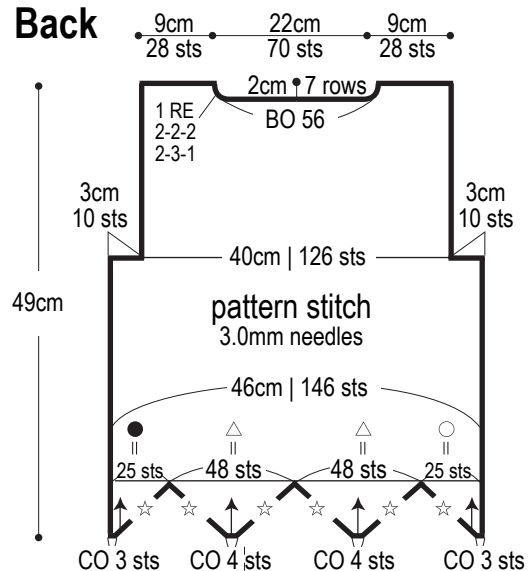


Pattern stitch A 3.0mm needles

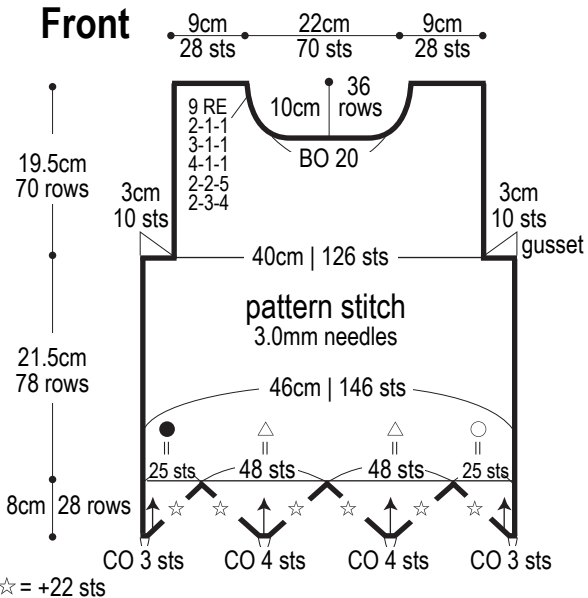

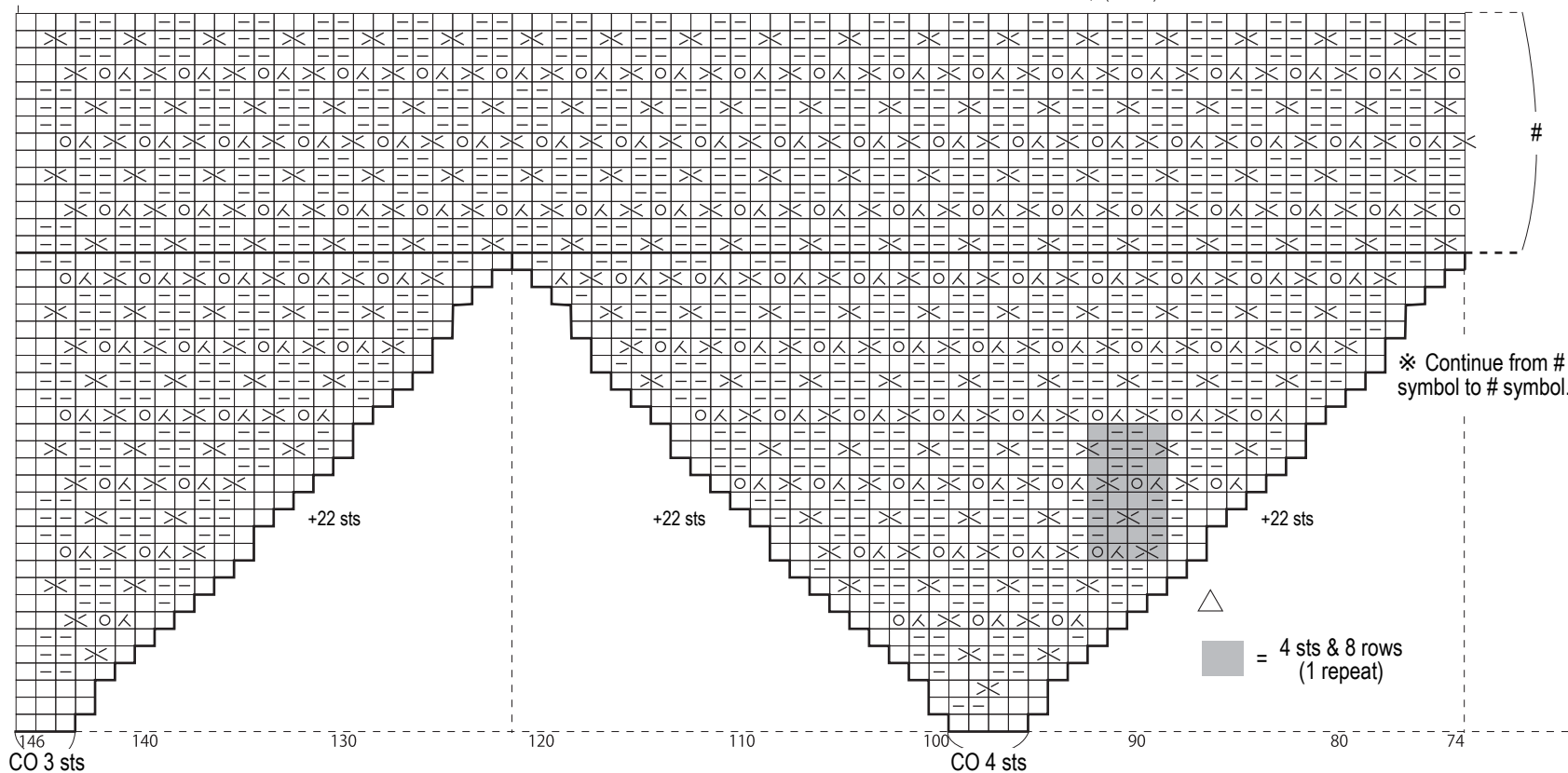
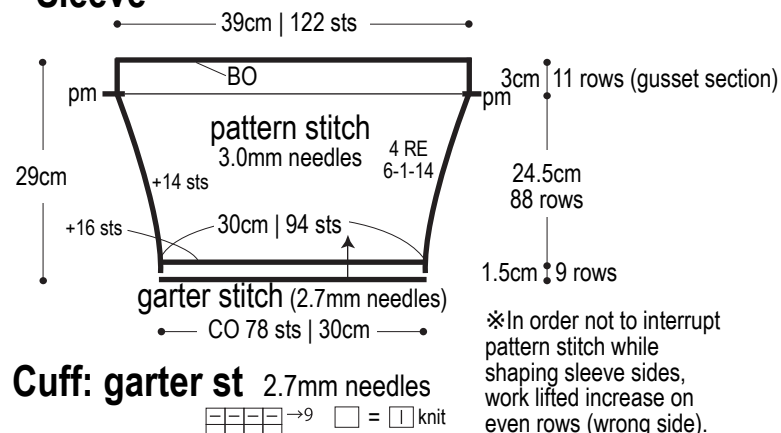
