215s-09 Lace-up Slippers



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Amijin Cotton 100 [100% cotton; 137 yds/125m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #9 iris, 2 skeins [45g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (US B or C) and 3.0mm (US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- transparent elastic reinforcement thread

Finished measurements:

• foot length 21cm/8.27"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• double crochet (US): 30 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

ch8 to begin. Work toe in the round. Work sole back and forth in rows. ch24, then begin working in the round again for the heel. Work 2 rounds of dc around toe, sole, and heel sections. Work 1 round of dc & sc as well (see schematic). Work instep in pattern stitch. Work 1 round of pattern stitch around mouth of slipper. Work back of heel in pattern stitch. Crochet 2 laces, each worked with 2 strands of yarn held together. Thread laces through slippers as shown in finishing schematic.

ch = chain



Slipper instructions *Aside from laces, work entire slipper with 2.5mm hook. 2. Work heel. whipstitch work 24 sts work 24 sts into chain into dc sts 3. Work edging into sts of toe, sole, and heel. dc: 2 rounds sc: 1 round _ dc: 3 rounds 2cm | 3 rounds ★Work 143 dc sts around 25 sts (see chart in step 4). toe 18 sts -start heel 20 sts 30 sts Work together with elastic reinforcement thread.













5. Work pattern stitch around edges.








7. Crochet 2 laces.
