# 215s-17 Yo-yo Dot Basket



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Raffia [100% rayon; 124 yds/113m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
  - version A:
    - color #77 grape, 2 skeins [95g]
    - color #79 papaya, 6 skeins [285g]
  - · version B:
    - color #75 apple green, 2 skeins [70g]
    - color #88 magenta pink, 7 skeins [325g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

• 3.0mm (US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

#### Finished measurements:

· Please refer to schematics.

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• single crochet (US) stitch: 19 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

### Summary

\*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

**Bottom:** Work magic ring to begin, ch1 for post, then work sc in the round. Block to required size with iron.

**Sides:** Continuing from bottom, work 1 round in sc tbl. Continue in pattern stitch (sc intarsia) in the round without posts (that is, working in a continuous spiral, *not* in joined rounds). Note: when working intarsia, carry the non-working yarn by working the working around around it (encasing it with the working yarn).


