

424ac Check Arm Cover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Milly [65% linen, 35% ramie; 112 yds/102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #02 oriental red, 2 skeins [50g]
 - color #06 royal blue, 2 skeins [50g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4), 2.3mm (approx. US B), 2.5mm (approx. US B or C), or 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- length 37cm/14.57"
- refer to schematic for other measurements

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 2.0mm hook): 30 sts and 18 rows
- pattern stitch (with 3.0mm hook): 24 sts and 16 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Arm covers: Work foundation chain to begin and join into the round. Work in pattern stitch, changing color every other round. Make second arm cover to match the first.

Edging: At wrist end, work 2 rounds of sc edging with same color as last round of pattern stitch. At elbow end, work 2 rounds of sc edging with same color as used for foundation chain.

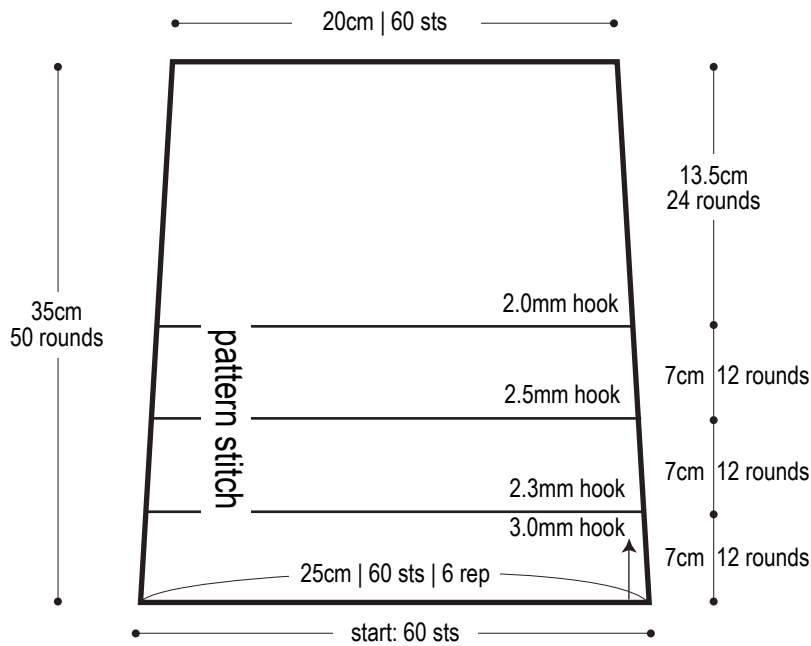
Abbreviations:

ch = chain

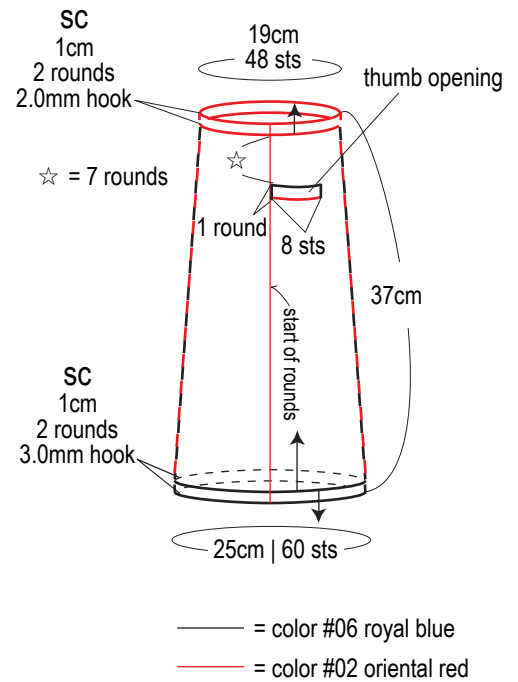
rep = pattern repeat(s)
