

827turban Lobe Turban



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Lobe [50% cotton, 50% acrylic; 109 yds/100m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
 - version A: color #01 rose brown, 1 skein [40g]
 - version B: color #06 earth blue, 1 skein [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 46cm/18.11"
- width 8.5cm/3.35"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- k1p1 ribbing: 36 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing (but work 2 knit stitches at each edge rather than 1). After working 64 rows, work large cable on row 65. Continue in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off all stitches. Seam bind-off edge to cast-on edge with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

blco inc = backwards loop cast-on increase

BO = bind off


CO = cast on

k = knit stitch

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl stitch


Turban schematic




※Because the turban is worked in k1p1 ribbing, it can stretch to up to 60cm.

Finishing

Seam cast-on edge to bind-off each with crochet slip stitch seam with right sides of turban facing each other.



cable at front center



※Work cable on row 65, taking care that stitches at either edge do not drop off needles.
