Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Wild Life [100% hemp; 120 yds/110m per 3.53 oz./100g hank];
 - version A:
 - color #03 salvia blue, 3 hanks [245g]
 - color #05 spring green, 1 hank [95g]
 - version B:
 - color #02 beige, 3 hanks [245g]
 - color #14 blue black, 1 hank [95g]

- version C:
 - color #01 white, 3 hanks [245g]
 - color #04 sky blue, 1 hank [45g]
 - color #17 purple, 1 hank [50g]
- version D:
 - color #08 ocean blue, 2 hanks [120g]
 - color #09 pink, 2 hanks [125g]
 - · color #13 olive drab, 1 hank [95g]

Tools/Notions:

• 5.0mm (US H) and 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

width 30cm/11.81"height 21cm/8.27"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch w/6.0mm (US J) crochet hook: 12 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note 1: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Note 2: Work body of clutch with 2 strands of yarn held together. (For versions C and D, some sections will be worked with 2 strands, each of a different color). Sc edging worked with 1 strand of yarn. Refer to schematic for color sequences.


Body: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc. Change color for flap and continue working in sc.

Finishing: Fold body of clutch where indicated. Seam sides by working sc edging around edges.

ch = chain sc = single crochet (US)
