# 215aw-16 Rhombus Design Bag



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Giselle [80% merino wool, 20% nylon; 83 yds/76m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #02 navy, 3 skeins [90g]
  - color #03 maple leaf, 3 skeins [100g]
  - color #04 thyme, 3 skeins [105g]
- color #05 raspberry pink, 4 skeins [130g]

# Tools/Notions:

• 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bag circumference 110cm/43.31"
- depth 31cm/12.20"

# Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• single crochet (US): 16 sts and 19 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### Summary

\*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Motifs: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc, increasing and decreasing as shown in charts to create diamong and triangle shapes. Refer to schematics for color sequences and number required of each shape/color combination.

Handle (make 2): Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc.

Finishing: Referring to schematic, seam motifs together with right side facing using whipstitch. Turn bag inside-out, then make gusset. Attach handles to bag with whipstitch.

ch = chain sc = single crochet (US) WS = wrong side
