215aw-24 Cagoule Snood



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Norn [49% wool, 48% acrylic, 3% nylon; 66 yds/60m per 3.53 oz./100g hank]; color #04 spicy red, 4 hanks [360g]

Tools/Notions:

• 12.0mm (approx. US P) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 30cm/11.81"
- circumference 142cm/55.91"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 9 sts and 6 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.


Body: Work foundation chain to begin. Work loosely in pattern stitch.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other (that is, right-side out), seam foundation edge to bind-off edge using whipstitch.


