215w-12 Owl Cap



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Bulky [100% merino wool; 44 yds/40m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #3 brown, 2 skeins [70g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.3mm (approx. US 101/2) and 7.0mm (no close US equivalent) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- 2 buttons (10mm/0.39" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 44cm/17.32"
- depth 20cm/7.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- reverse stockinette stitch: 12.5 sts and 17.5 rows
- pattern stitch: 16 sts and 17.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Cap: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and reverse stockinette stitch according to schematic. When finished, place all stitches on stitch holder; do not bind off. Remove provisional cast-on edge, picking up the live stitches as you go. Work edging in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off ribbing in pattern. Fold in half where indicated at side of hat, then graft live stitches at top of hat together using Kitchener stitch. Seam remaining side together with mattress stitch.

Finishing: Make 2 pompoms. Fasten pompoms and buttons to hat where indicated on finishing schematic.


