215w-12 Owl Mittens



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino [100% merino wool; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #7 brown, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.5mm (US 7) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- 4 buttons (8mm/0.31" diameter)

Finished measurements:

• palm circumference 16.5cm/6.50"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- reverse stockinette stitch: 22 sts and 32 rows
- pattern stitch: 29 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

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Summary


Right mitten: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and reverse stockinette stitch in the round. On palm side of mitten, work thumb stitches on waste yarn. Seam fingertip area by grafting live stitches together with Kitchener stitch (reverse st st style). Remove provisional cast-on edge, picking up live stitches as you go. Work k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off ribbing in pattern. Remove waste yarn from thumb stitches; pick up live thumb stitches and work thumb in st st the round. On last round of thumb, thread yarn through all remaining stitches and cinch shut. Fasten buttons to eye area of owls as indicated in finishing schematic.

Left mitten: Reverse shaping of right mitten.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit stitch k2tog = knit two stitches together OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder) p = purl stitch PU = pick up st st = stockinette stitch #-#-# = rounds-stitches-times
