

215w-09 Men's Switch Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino [100% merino wool; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #10 navy, 12 skeins [450g]
- Pierrot Yarns Alternate Wool [100% merino wool; 98 yds/90m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #04 nordic, 4 skeins [160g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (23mm/0.91")

Finished measurements:

- chest 105.5cm/41.54"
- center back neck-to-cuff 83.5cm/32.87"
- back length 64cm/25.20"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- moss stitch: 19.5 sts and 33 rows
- pattern stitch: 19.5 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back, right front, and right sleeve: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then moss stitch, then pattern stitch. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases 3 stitches in from the edge. Reverse shaping of right front/sleeve for left front/sleeve.

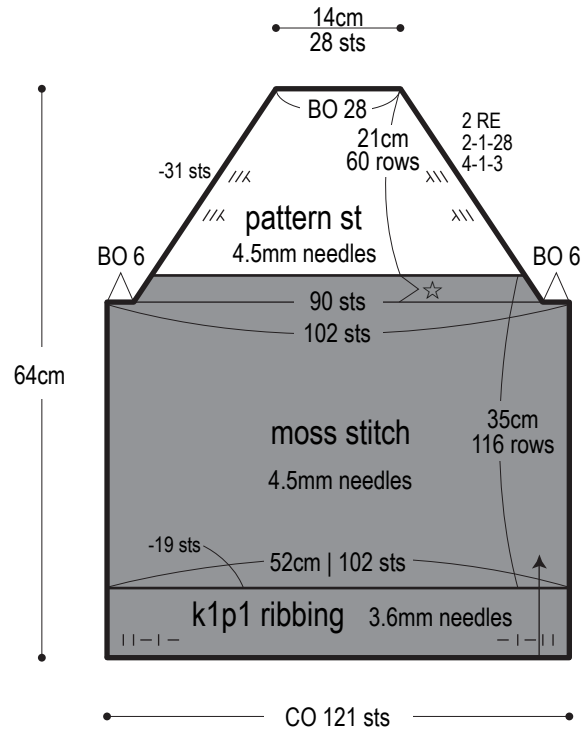
Buttonband: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, working buttonholes as you go. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Seam underarm gussets with Kitchener stitch. Seam each side from cuff to hem with one continuous mattress stitch seam. Seam buttonband to body and front neckline with mattress stitch; seam to back neckline with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch.

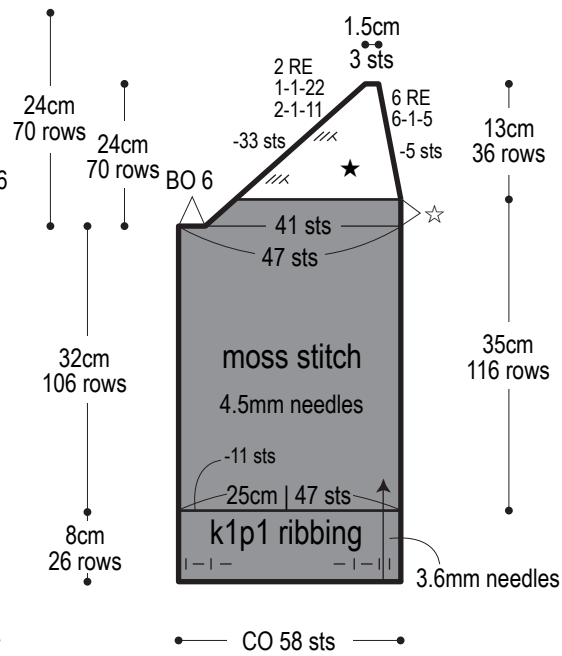
BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit stitch p = purl stitch RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

※Reverse shaping for left front.

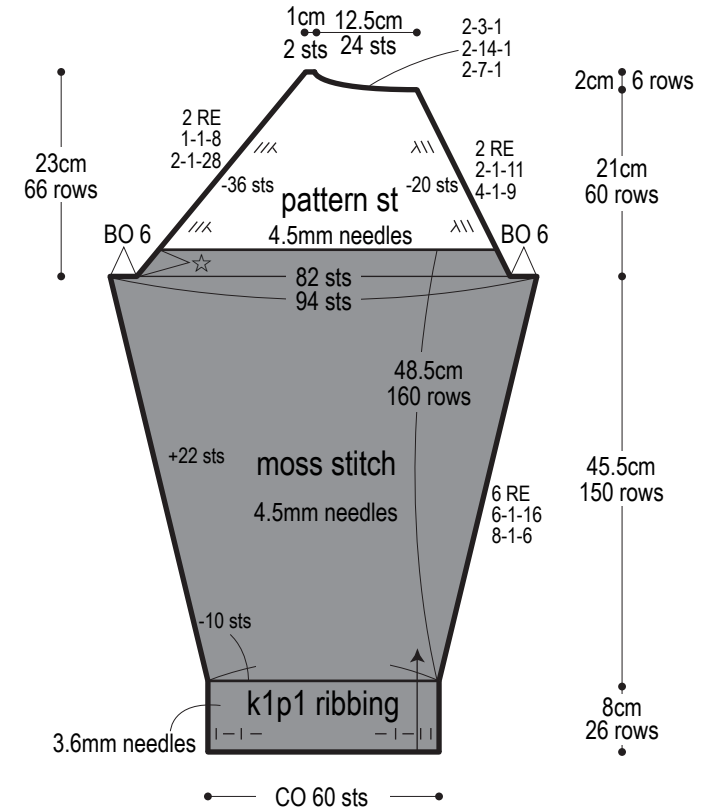


☆ = 3cm | 10 rows

Right sleeve

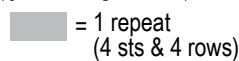

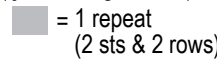


Diagram illustrating the finishing details of a garment, specifically the neckline, button placket, and sleeves. The diagram shows the following components and measurements:
