215w-01 Cats Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- PurpleYarns Wildcat Long Fur [92% nylon, 8% polyester; 44 yds/40m per 3.53 oz./100g hank]; color #01 ivory, 6 hanks [590g]
- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino [100% merino wool; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #6 light beige 2 skeins [50g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 12.0mm (US 17) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hooks or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- bust 99.5cm/39.17"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 63.5cm/25.00"
- sleeve length 56cm/22.05"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

stockinette stitch: 8.5 sts and 8.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch.

Front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch. Shape curve at hem edge by working backwards loop cast-on increase.

Sleeve: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch. Shape sleeve cap by binding off stitches as indicated and by working decreases at edges. Pick up stitches along cast-on edge; work cuff in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.


Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Work sc edging in the round around hm, front edges, and neckline, working buttonholes in right front edging as you go. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even sc = single crochet (US) #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
