# 215w-16 Chevron Set



### Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Momo-little [100% merino wool; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
- · armwarmers:
  - color #04 la France, 1 skein [20g]
  - color #08 horizom, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #09 grege, 2 skeins [35g]
  - color #10 ivy gray, 1 skein [25g]

- haramaki (stomach band):
  - color #04 la France, 1 skein [20g]
  - color #08 horizom, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #09 grege, 1 skein [30g]
  - color #10 ivy gray, 1 skein [25g]

- · legwarmers:
  - color #09 grege, 5 skeins [130g]
  - color #10 ivy gray, 1 skein [15g]

### **Tools/Notions:**

• 2.7mm (approx. US 2), 3.0mm (US 3), and 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

### Finished measurements:

- armwarmers:
  - circumference 20cm/7.87"
  - length 43.5cm/17.13"

- haramaki (stomach band):
  - circumference 54cm/21.26"
- lenath 35.5cm/13.98"

- · legwarmers:
  - circumference 28cm/11.02"
  - length 50.5cm/19.88"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 3.0mm needles): 35 sts and 38 rows
- pattern stitch (with 3.3mm needles): 33 sts and 37 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

## Summary

**❖Note:** Refer to schematics for color sequences.

Armwarmers (make 2): CO with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, pattern stitch, and then k1p1 ribbing again. Bind off in pattern. With wrong sides facing each other, seam sides with mattress stitch. At bind-off edge, use half backstitch to form thumb opening.

Haramaki (stomach band): CO with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and k1p1 ribbing. Bind off with 1x1 tubular bind-off method. With wrong sides facing each other, seam sides with mattress stitch.


Legwarmers (make 2): CO with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. With wrong sides facing each other, seam sides with mattress stitch.

BO = bind offCO = cast onk = knit lruq = q

PU = pick up

R = row(s)



\*For haramaki and legwarmers, CO row counts as first row of pattern stitch.
