Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns KUKKA [60% acrylic, 40% wool; 92 yds/84m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #06 mandarin orange, 1 skein [13g]
 - color #13 beige, 1 skein [16g]
 - color #14 amber, 1 skein [12g]
 - color #15 brown, 1 skein [35g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- tapestry needle
- 2 safety eyes (8mm/0.31" diameter)
- · pink embroidery thread or yarn
- · polyfiber stuffing

Finished measurements:

• height (in seated position): 13.5cm/5.31"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Please use hook size necessary to achieve a fabric sufficiently dense so that stuffing will not show through.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Head, nose, arms, legs, ears, and tail: Work magic ring to begin, then work in sc according to respective charts. Leave yarn tail when binding off to use for seaming later.


Torso: ch3 and join into the round. Work sc in the round (note that first round will work into both sides of chain).

Vest and hat: For vest, ch31 to begin and work in striped sc. For hat, work magic ring to begin, then work hat striped sc in the round.


Finishing: Insert stuffing into all parts except vest. Seam all parts except vest together as shown in finishing schematics. Fasten safety eyes to head and embroider features onto face.





Finishing: face









Tail (make 1) color #15, 3.5mm hook


Leg (make 2) 3.5mm hook









Arm (make 2) 3.5mm hook






Finishing: arm


Finishing: leg
