

824cap Cable Knit Cap



Suggested yarn:

- Baruffa Cashmere [100% cashmere; 118 yds/108m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - color #016 navy, 3 skeins [65g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- darning needle

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 48cm/18.90"
- hat length 24cm/9.45"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 28.5 sts and 41 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 39 rows in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch for 74 rows. On the next row, begin decreases. After working last row, cut yarn and thread yarn tail through all remaining stitches. Cinch top of hat shut and weave in yarn tail. Seam side of hat and weave in yarn tail.

Abbreviations:


C8F = slip 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of work, k4 from left needle, k4 from cable needle

CO = cast on


k = knit

p = purl
