

Hanna Drop-stitch Camisole



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Hanna [48% cotton, 36% rayon, 16% linen; 157 yds/144m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #5 wysteria mist, 4 skeins [130g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4), 2.3mm (approx. US B), and 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 23cm/9.06"
- back length 54.5cm/21.46"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 18 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Seam sides with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). For shoulder straps, work 2 separate crochet chains, each 14 sts long. Seam to final row of body. Work sc edging in the round around neckline, each armhole, and hem, respectively.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
ch = chain st
CO = cast on
k = knit stitch
RE = row(s) even
rep = pattern repeat(s)
sc = single crochet (US)
= rows-stitches-times
