216ss-07 Ethnic Dress



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pochette [50% superwash merino wool, 50% cotton; 131 yds/120m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #01 pure white, 5 skeins [180g]
 - color #09 violet, 2 skeins [60g]
 - color #12 platinum gray, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

• 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 140cm/55.12"
- back length 85cm/33.46"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• mesh stitch: 8 chain spaces and 7.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Front & back: Make 2 identical triangles, which will form lower front and back sides (see areas marked ① and ② on schematic). Begin working center of hem according to schematic (section ③ for back and section ④ for front), connecting each side to one of the triangles as you go so that the triangles will be connected to the body.

Lacing: With 3 strands of color #09 held together, crochet the cord to be used to lace up the neckline.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with whipstitch. Lace the cord through body as indicated in finishing schematic.




