Ribbon Poncho



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Fouatons [58% acrylic, 30% nylon, 12% wool; 328 yds/300m per 0.88 oz./ 25g skein]; color #09 mint, 2 skeins [40g]
- Keito-Zakka Stores Fuwari [88% acrylic, 12% mohair; 71 yds/65m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #08 turquoise blue, 2 skeins [70g]

Tools/Notions:

- 7.0mm (no US equivalent) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hooks or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

• back length 30cm/11.81"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- seed stitch: 8 sts and 13 rounds
- double crochet (US) with 4.0mm hook: 16 sts and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: When working with Funwari, use 1 strand of yarn. When working with Foutaons, use 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Cast on with crochet cast-on method, then work seed stitch in the round. Work evenly spaced decreases according to schematic and chart. Bind off all stitches. With crochet hook, work edging around hem of poncho.

Ribbon: With crochet hook, work foundation chain to begin. Work in dc.

Finishing: Seam ribbon to bind-off edge of poncho with whipstitch, leaving 5 sts at front of poncho unseamed and leaving the ribbon ends to hang free. Tie ribbon ends into a bow knot.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

ch = chain stitch


CO = cast on

dc = double crochet (US)

rep = pattern repeat(s)

#-#-#= rows-stitches-places-times [for evenly spaced decreases]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 round, decrease 2 stitches in each of 3 places across the round; do this 4 times total."


Poncho schematic



double left decrease = slip 1 st knitwise, knit 2 sts together (k2tog), pass slipped st over k2tog.




2 strands of Fouatons




Note: section marked with \(\sigma \) above is the part to be seamed to poncho neckline.


Finishing
