

Trinity Outing Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Trinity [100% jute; 87 yds/80m per 3.53 oz./100g hank];
 - color #02 cool beige, 2 hanks [140g]
 - color #05 pink rose, 4 hanks [360g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 pair leather handles (42cm/16.54" long)
- 2 pieces of rope to use as core for sc

Finished measurements:

- width 16cm/6.30"
- length 26cm/10.24"
- height 32cm/12.60"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 17 sts and 10 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Bottom: ch54 to begin. Work in sc, working each stitch around rope (encasing the rope into sc stitches). Work 1 round of sc edging around all four edges of bottom piece *without* rope.

Sides: Continuing from bottom, working first round of sc sts into outer edges of bottom piece. Working in the round, continue working in sc sts worked around rope as before. Change yarn color where indicated.


Finishing: Work slip stitch along vertical edges at each of the four corners (refer to finishing schematic). Sew handles to bag.

Abbreviations:


ch = chain

sc = single crochet (US)


Bag schematic



Finishing




Bottom




ch54 to begin, then work 16 rows of sc with rope encased in stitches (see instructions below).


How to encase rope in sc & how to finish



Hold rope along with yarn, then work sc around rope so that rope is completely encased in sc stitches.



Cut 1 strand of the rope and work 3 more sc stitches.



Cut 1 more strand of the rope, work 3 more sc stitches, then slip stitch.
