

216ss-04 Cotton Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Ami Cotton Bulky [100% cotton; 115 yds/105m per 3.53 oz./100g skein];
 - color #05 baby blue, 4 skeins [315g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10) & 6.6mm (approx. US 10.5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 37cm/14.57"
- back length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 12 sts and 18 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 12 sts and 20 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** For all seaming, use just one ply of Ami Cotton Bulky.

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in garter stitch, and then continue in stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitches, but work through half stitches instead of whole stitches. Pick up stitches around neckline; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Fold collar in half towards inside and tack down with whipstitch. Crochet armhole edging in the round.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit stitch

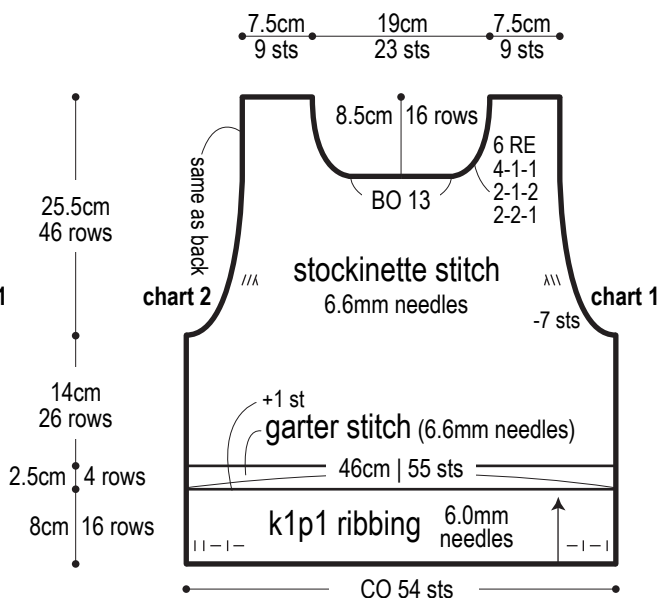
p = purl stitch

PU = pick up

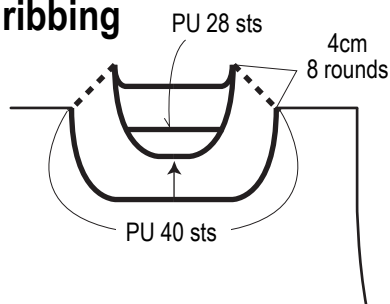
RE = row(s) even
