

216ss-09 Multi Stripe Tee



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Orgabits One [100% cotton; 142 yds/130m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #09 oriental blue, 2 skeins [80g]
 - color #12 honey gold, 2 skeins [45g]
 - color #13 vermillion, 2 skeins [50g]
 - color #15 natural, 4 skeins [125g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- chest 106cm/41.73"
- center back neck-to-cuff 47cm/18.50"
- back length 61.5cm/24.21"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch. Seam shoulders together with three-needle bind-off method.

Sleeve (make 2): Pick up stitches between markers on front and back body. Work sleeve in pattern stitch, then finish in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline and work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit stitch

p = purl stitch

pm = place marker

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times

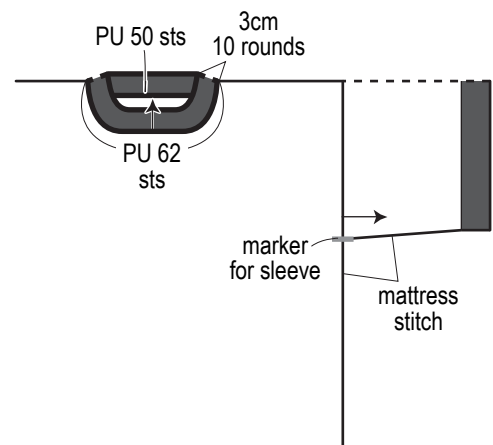

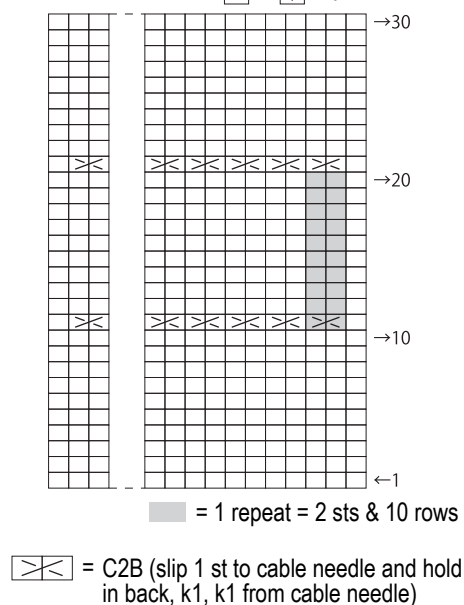
