

# 216ss-17 Cabled Summer Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Cotton [100% cotton; 60 yds/55m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
  - ladies' size: color #2 coffee milk, 16 skeins [470g]
- Pierrot Yarns Basic Cotton Colors [100% cotton; 60 yds/55m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
  - men's size: color #15 herbal green, 18 skeins [530g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 23 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch B: 6cm/2.36" = 17 sts and 10cm/4" = 28 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 25 sts and 32 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

✳️ **Note:** Ladies' front neckline is a V-neck, while men's front neckline is a crew neck.

**Body and sleeves:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in pattern stitches A and B. Work sleeves in the same manner. Shape raglan edges with fully fashioned decreases (worked 1 stitch in from the edge).

**Finishing:** Seam gusset with Kitchener stitch. Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides and sleeves with one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side).

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even


ssk = slip, slip, knit = slip 1 st knitwise, slip 1 more st knitwise, return these 2 sts to left needle; k2tog through back

### = rows-stitches-times












