216ss-18 Basket Hat



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Cotton [100% cotton; 60 yds/55m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - kids' size: color #10 sky gray, 4 skeins [100g]
 - adult size: color #11 navy blue, 5 skeins [130g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5m/2.73 yds. of spindle cord for drawstring (4mm/0.16" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- kids' size:
 - head circumference 52.5cm/20.67"
 - depth 7.5cm/2.95"

- adult size:
 - head circumference 57cm/22.44"
 - · depth 8.5cm/3.35"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• single crochet (US): 21 sts and 25.5 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Top of hat: Work magic ring to begin, then work sc in the round. Increase as indicated in chart.

Sides of hat: Continuing from top, work 1 round of sc tbl in the round. Continue in sc in the round (see chart).

Brim of hat: Continuing from side of hat, work brim in the round, increasing as indicated. Work final round in twisted sc. Crochet cord stop. Thread drawstring through hat and cord stop. Knot ends of drawstring. Using two strands of Basic Cotton held together, embroider stripes around sides of hat.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain m = magic ring/circle rep = pattern repeat(s) sc = single crochet (US) tbl = through back loop only


Cord stop (make 1 per hat)

2.5mm hook




Kid's size color #10 sky gray
