

903poncho Lacy Poncho



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Le Rhone [85% ramie, 15% linen; 202 yds/185m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #09 musc, 6 skeins [185g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- back length 41.5cm/16.34"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 30 sts and 13 rows
- pattern stitch B: 30 sts and 8 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body of poncho: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitches A and B according to schematic and stitch charts.


Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain stitch and sc stitch. Work edgings A and B.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

sc = single crochet (US)
