

Leaf Pattern Summer Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores La Choutte [70% cotton, 30% merino wool; 197 yds/180m per 1.23 oz./ 35g skein]; color #05 mimosa, 4 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) circular knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hooks or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- back length 59cm/23.23"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 32 sts and 36 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

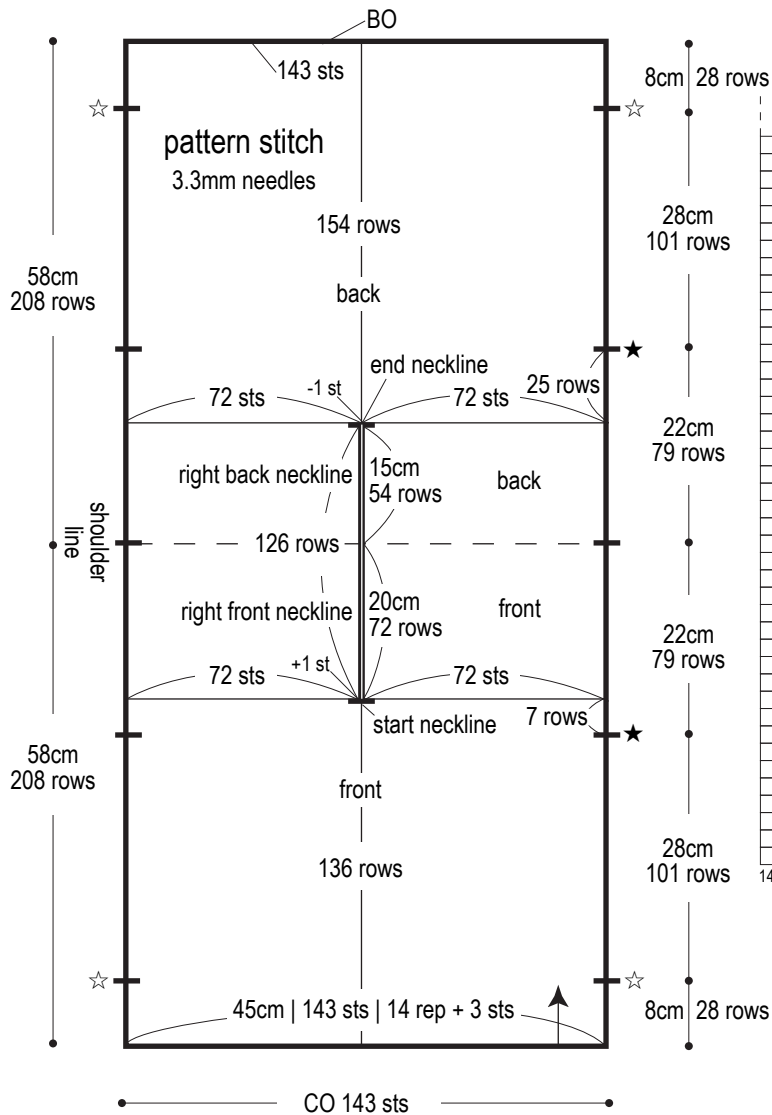
Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work front sideways from hem towards neckline in pattern stitch. Where neckline begins, separate work and work right and left sides separately, but for right front neckline only, increase 1 stitch at edge. Work right and left sides separately, but at right back neckline edge, k2tog to reduce to 143 stitches. Bind off.

Finishing: Side seams (except for side slits where marked) using mattress stitch. Crochet edging along hem, including side slit edges (see finishing schematics). Work crochet edging in the round along cuffs and neckline, respectively.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k2tog = knit two stitches together
pm = place marker
rep = pattern repeat(s) = multiples
sc = single crochet (US)
sc2tog = single crochet (US) two stitches together
sc3tog = single crochet (US) three stitches together

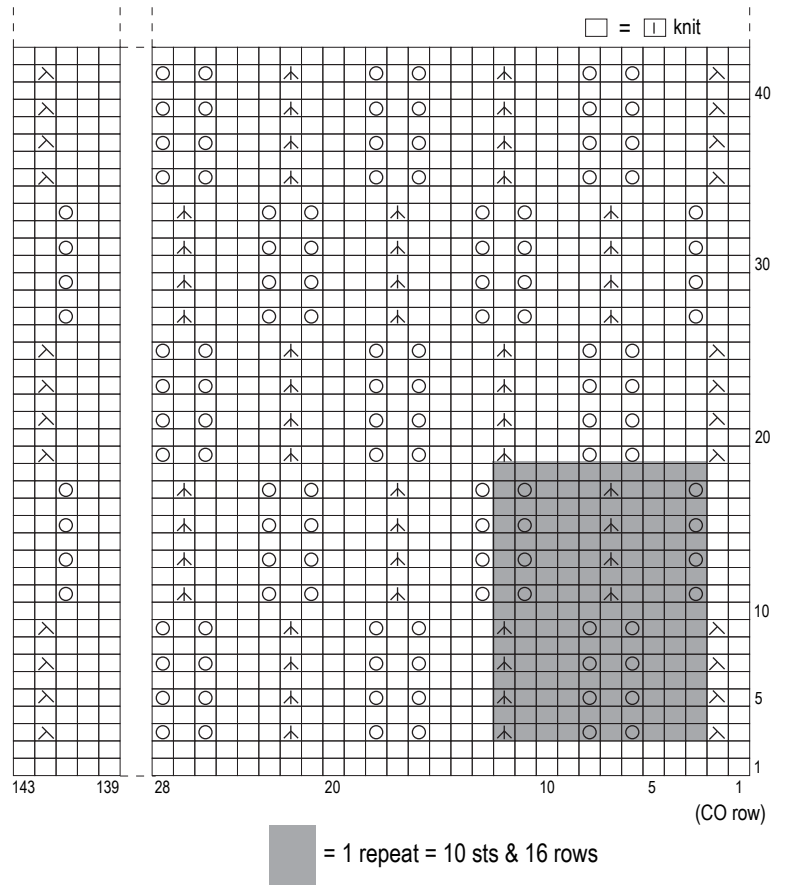

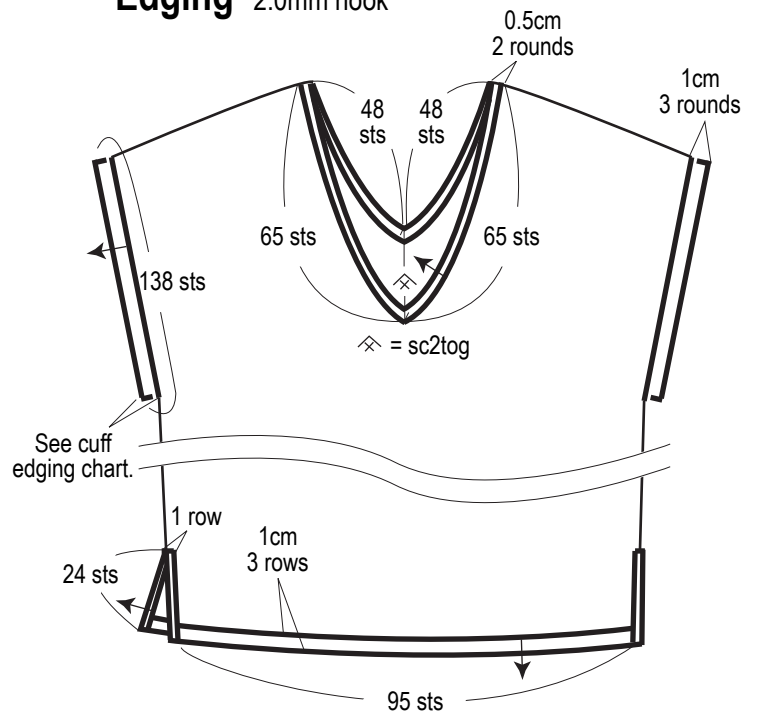
☆ = pm for side slit

★ = pm for sleeve

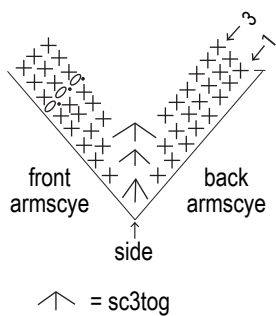
Pattern stitch 3.3mm needles
