

Lapin Girly Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Lapin [100% cotton; 131 yds/120m per 1.41 oz./40g cone];
- color #06 pluie, 9 cones [325g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- chiffon ribbon (3.5cm/1.38" wide, 70cm/27.56" long)

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- center back neck-to-cuff 37cm/14.57"
- back length 49.5cm/19.49"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch B and stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 38 rows
- pattern stitch A: 26 sts and 37 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch A and stockinette stitch. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases 2 stitches in from the edge. For back only, bind off all stitches (no shaping). For front, bind off stitches as indicated and work decreases as indicated to shape neckline.

Sleeve (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch B and stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Align ☆ on body to ☆ on sleeve; seam together with Kitchener stitch. Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Starting at hem, seam sides with mattress stitch, continuing through underside of sleeve. Pick up stitches around neckline; work garter stitch in the round, also working eyelets for threading ribbon through collar (see chart). Bind off from wrong side.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
rep = pattern repeat(s)
= rows-stitches-times

Top Edge:

- 13cm / 35 sts

Shoulder Slope:

- BO 2 (2 RE 2-2-1, 2-4-2)
- same as back

Sleeve Cap:

- BO 23 (-30 sts)
- same as front

Wrist Edge:

- 2cm / 8 rows
- 15cm / 58 rows
- BO 8 (7 RE 6-1-4, 9-1-1)
- BO 8 (+5 sts)

Body Dimensions:

- 17cm / 66 rows
- 10.5cm / 40 rows
- 1.5cm / 6 rows

Pattern Details:

- 39.5cm / 107 sts
- 36cm / 97 sts
- pattern st B
- 3.0mm needles
- 2.7mm needles
- 21 sts
- k1p1 ribbing
- CO 118 sts

Finishing

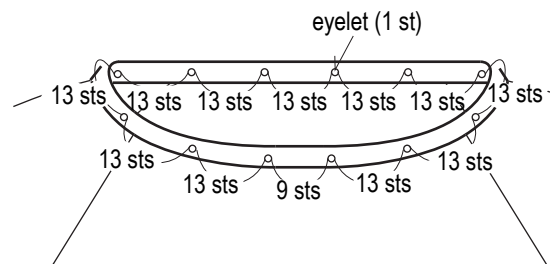
