

Sugar Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Sugar [71% mohair, 21% nylon, 8% wool; 151 yds/138m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #01 white, 6 skeins [180g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 7) and 4.8mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.2mm (approx. US 7) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 104cm/40.94"
- center back neck-to-cuff 62.5cm/24.61"
- back length 59cm/23.23"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- reverse stockinette stitch: 16 sts and 23 rows
- pattern stitch: 16.5 sts and 23 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. For back, continue in pattern stitch. For front, continue in pattern stitch and reverse stockinette stitch (see schematic).

Sleeve (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sleeve undersides and sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
= rows-stitches-times

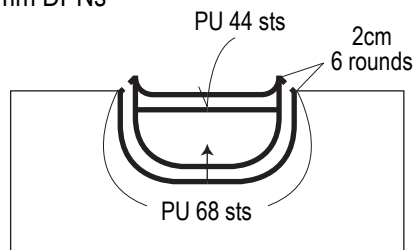

The pattern stitch is -3 sts and 4.8mm needles. The pattern stitch is -11 sts and 55cm | 91 sts. The pattern stitch is k1p1 ribbing 4.2mm needles and CO 102 sts.

- Upper Chest Hips:** 19cm (32 sts), 17cm (27 sts), 19cm (32 sts).
- Upper Chest Hem:** 2cm (6 rows).
- Upper Chest Ribbing:** k1p1 ribbing, 4.2mm needles, CO 102 sts.
