

Bicolor Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Fuwafuwa Bagel [85% acrylic, 15% wool; 49 yds/45m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #03 sesame, 7 skeins [280g]
 - color #07 tomato, 6 skeins [210g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.3mm (approx. US 10½) and 7.0mm (no close US equivalent) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.3mm (approx. US 10½) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- center back neck-to-cuff 70.5cm/27.76"
- back length 55.5cm/21.85"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- English rib stitch: 9 sts and 26 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in twisted k1p1 ribbing for 9 rows. Work next row in stockinette stitch, working decreases in this row. Continue in English rib. Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam.


Sleeves: Pick up stitches along front and back armhole areas. Work sleeve in English rib, then work 1 row of stockinette stitch, working decreases in this row. Work 11 rows in twisted k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam body and sleeve gusset areas together with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch.


Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- k = knit
- p = purl
- PU = pick up
- RE = row(s) even
- # #-# = rows-stitches-times


Back



Front




Sleeve



*Note: Work all 13 decreases in the stockinette stitch row.


*Note: Work all 7 increases in the stockinette stitch row.
