

Square Line Tabard Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Atelier Wool [100% wool; 83 yds/76m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #73 walnut, 2 skeins [50g]
 - color #74 susuki, 4 skeins [155g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.4mm (approx. US 9) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- garter stitch: 16 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in striped garter stitch, increasing with center double decreases (see schematic and chart). End with k3tog. Make second piece identical to the first. For both back and front, after striped garter stitch section is completed, pick up stitches along top edge and work neckline in garter stitch (without stripes). Shape neckline per schematic instructions.

Collar: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off with 1x1 tubular bind-off method.

Finishing: Crochet edging in the round. Crochet 2 straps and fasten to sides where shown on finishing schematic..

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

k3tog = knit 3 stitches together

p = purl

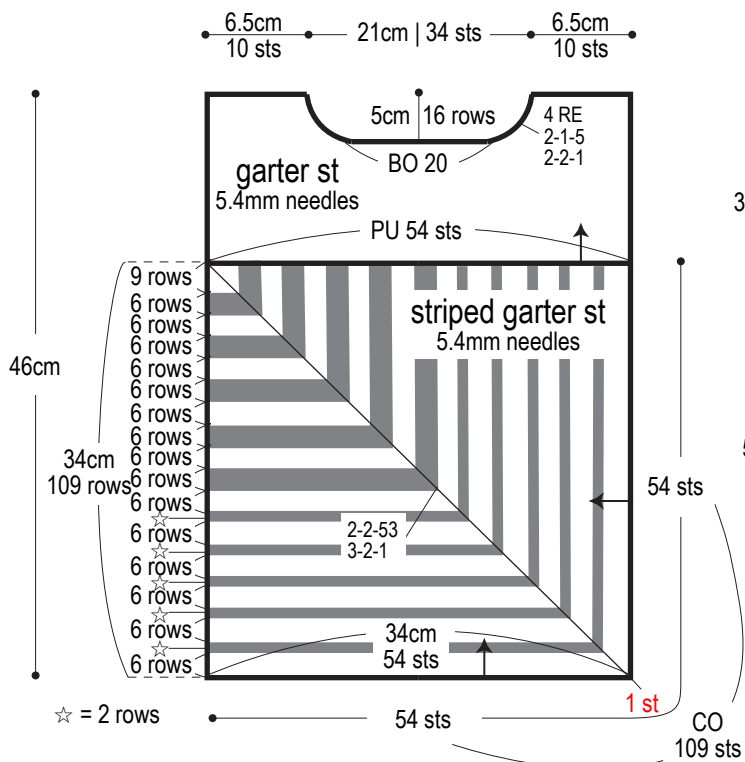
PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

sc = single crochet (US)

= rows-stitches-times

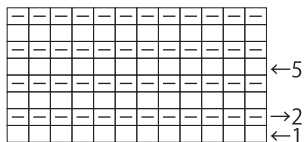

5.4mm needles

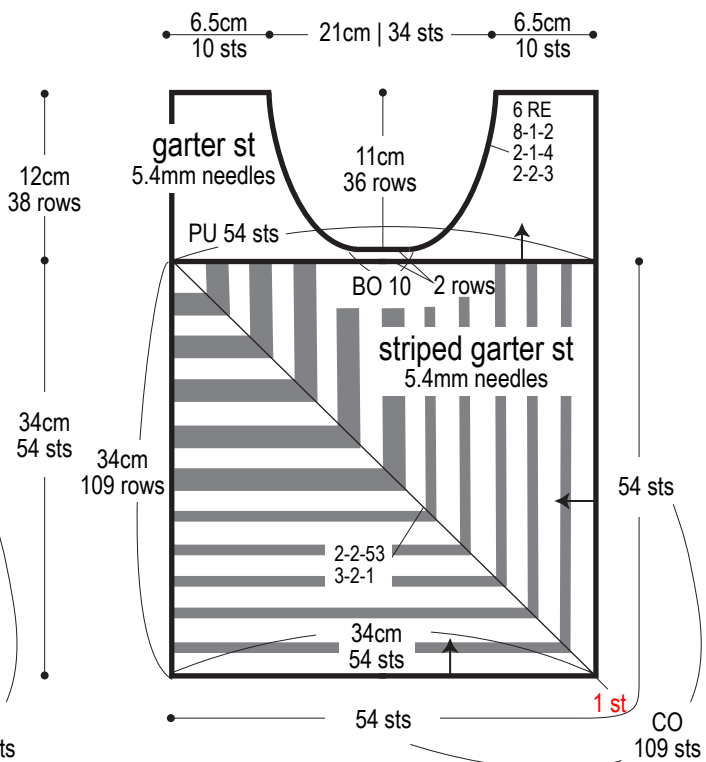
$\square = \square \mid \text{knit}$

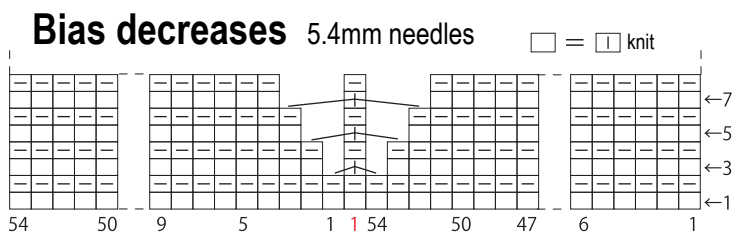
