

z192-kvest Fromage Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Fromage [650% cotton, 35% acrylic; 213 yds/195m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #05 pale orange, 2 skeins [50g]
 - color #06 cream yellow, 2 skeins [45g]
 - color #25,charcoal gray 1 skein [5g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 button (21mm/0.83")

Finished measurements:

- chest 76.2cm/30"
- cross back width 29.4cm/11.57"
- back length 38cm/14.96"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 30 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body: With color #06 cream yellow, work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch, changing color as indicated in charts.


Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Work edging A along hem edge. Work edging B along armhole, front edges, and neckline, working buttonholes in front edge as you go.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)


Body 2.3mm hook

Pattern stitch 2.3mm hook




Edging B 2.3mm hook

Armholes






Vest 2.3mm hook
