216aw-19 Block Pattern Sweater



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Junmo Gokubuto 2 [100% Wool; 57yds/52m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #104 autumn blue, 19 skeins [730g]

Tools/Notions:

• 4.2mm (approx. US 6), 4.5mm (US 7), and 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- · chest 105cm/41.34"
- cross back width 42.5cm/16.73"
- back length 61cm/24.02"
- sleeve length 61cm/24.02"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 16.5 sts and 25 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 17.5 sts and 28.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and pattern stitch. Shape armscye, neckline, and sleeve caps by binding off stitches as indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from the edge). Shape sleeves by working fully fashioned lifted increases (2 stitches in from the edge).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work garter stitch and k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
