

216w-03 Cross Pattern Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soupir Wool [53% merino wool, 31% acrylic, 15% lyocell, 1% silk; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #01 cream beige, 13 skeins [510g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 102cm/40.16"
- center back neck-to-cuff 64.5cm/25.39"
- back length 58cm/22.38"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 30 rows
- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 30 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 24 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch.

Front: Cast on as for back. Work in k1p1 ribbing, stockinette stitch, and pattern stitch.

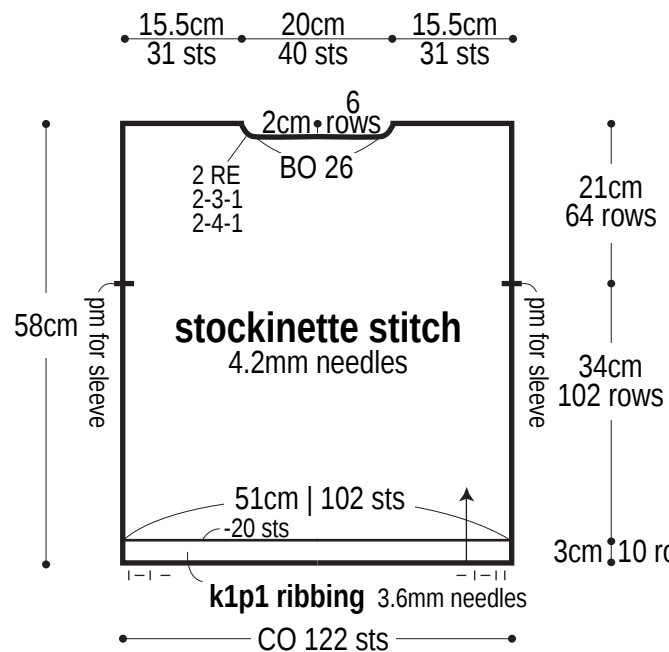
Sleeve (make 2): Cast on as for back. Work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch. Bind off.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Fold cuffs where indicated on finishing schematic.

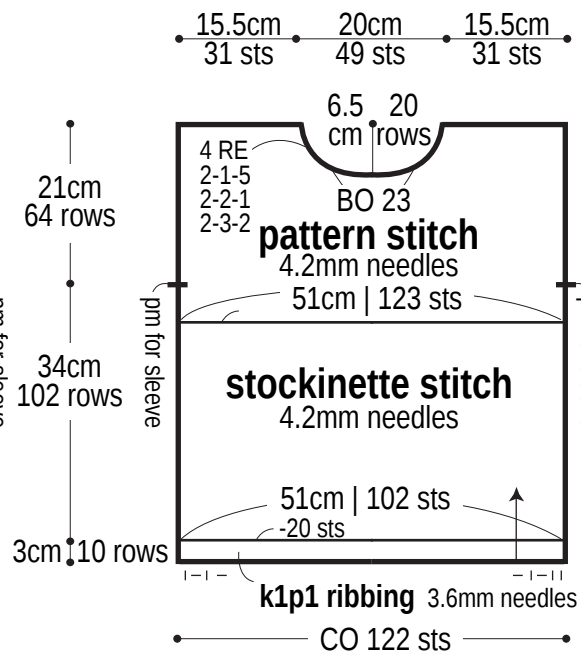
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette st #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

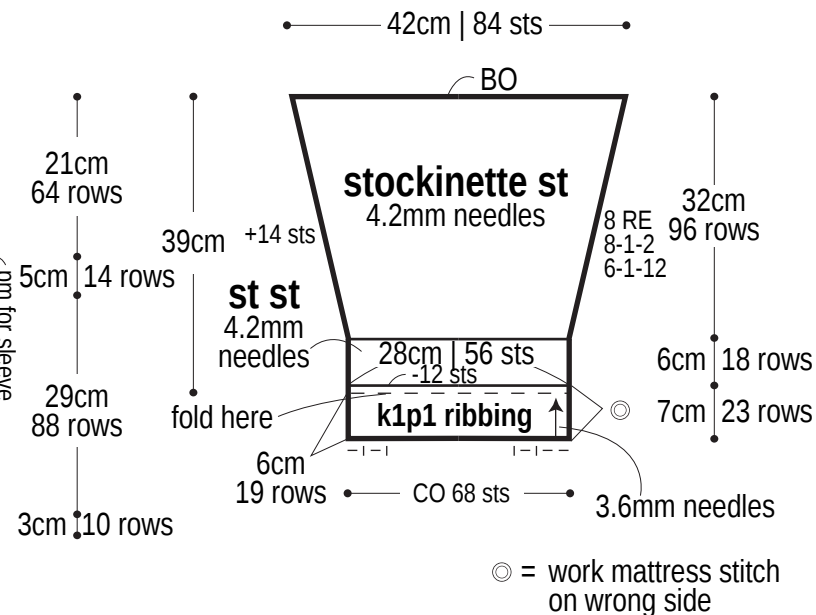

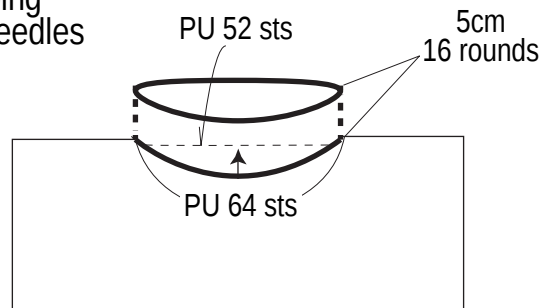


Sleeve

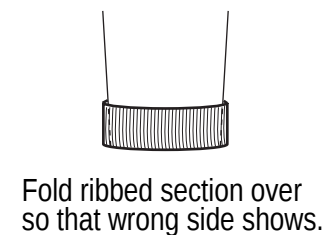


Collar

3.6mm needles



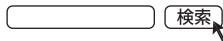
Cuff

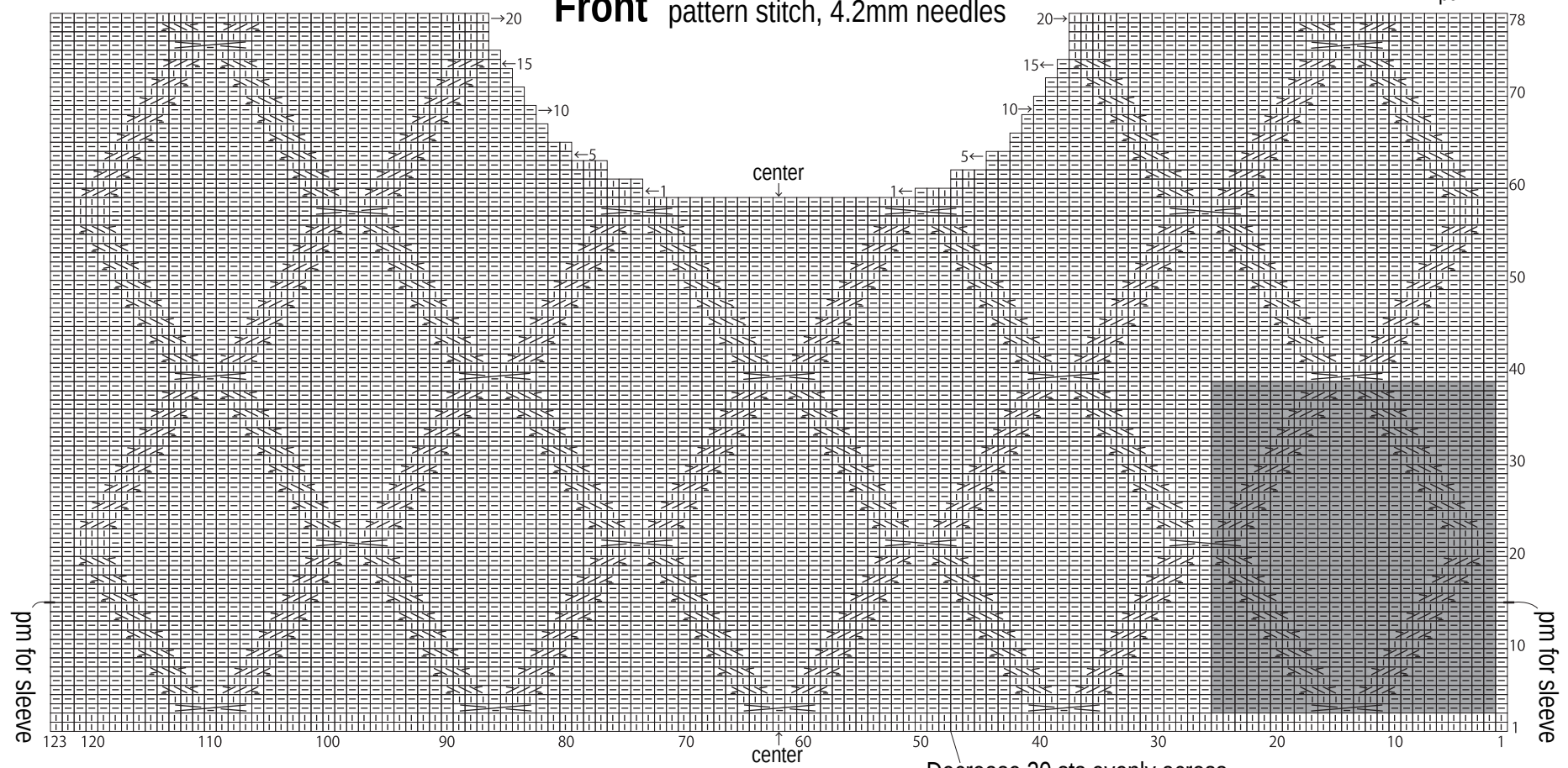




Front pattern stitch, 4.2mm needles



Sleeve

Decrease 20 sts evenly across.

■ = 1 repeat
 = 24 sts & 36 rows

-  =  = C7B Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in back, p1, k3, k3 from cable needle.
-  =  = C7F Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front, p1, k3, k3 from cable needle.
-  =  = C4B Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold in back, k3, p1 from cable needle.
-  =  = C4F Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front, p1, k3 from cable needle.
