27-28-37 Linked-ring tawashi



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Yuttari Acrylic [100% acrylic; 73 yds/67m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - version A:
 - color #83 smoke pink, 1 skein [6g]
 - color #87 light red brown, 1 skein [4g]
 - version B
 - · color #86 spring green, 1 skein [6g]
 - color #85 honey sweet, 1 skein [4g]
 - version C:
 - color #88 light navy blue, 1 skein [6g]
 - color #82 light cream, 1 skein [4g]

Tools/Notions:

• 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- length 10.5cm/4.13"
- width 10.5cm/4.13"

Gauge:

· motif diameter: approx. 6cm/2.36"

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.


Work first motif as follows: ch12 to begin, then join into the round; ch3 for post, work 23 dc into ring, then slip stitch into top of post (from beginning of round). Work rings ② to ④, linking them as you go. Work sc edging around all four motifs, which will help establish the square shape of the finished tawashi. While working edging, ch10 for a loop at one corner, slip stitch to close the loop, and continue with sc edging.


