303tree Triangle Tree



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% Wool Merino; 103yds/94m per 1.06oz/30g skein];
 color #201 Off-White, 1 skein [30g]
 - color #207 Forest Green, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 15g polyfiber stuffing
- ornaments or other decorations of your choice

Finished measurements:

- vertical 32.5cm/12.80"
- horizontal 32.5cm/12.80"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• motif at its longest point (altitude): 6.5cm/2.56"

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.


Motifs: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc while decreasing as indicated. Make 15 motifs in each color.

Finishing: Seam motifs together as follows: with wrong sides facing each other (right side facing you), take one motif of color #201 and one motif of color #207 and seam together along two sides using whipstitch. Insert stuffing, then seam remaining side closed using whipstitch. (Note: this results in triangles that are not the same color on each surface. Feel free to change color arrangements as desired.) Referring to finishing schematic, seam triangles together into tree shape using whipstich. Crochet loop and attach to tree. Fasten ornaments to tree where desired.

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Abbreviations:

ch = chain RS = right side sc = single crochet (US)
