

Happa Hat



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Merino Warm DK [60% wool, 40% merino wool; 96 yds/88m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #53 olive green, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #55 emerald blue, 2 skeins [45g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- sewing needle

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 50cm/19.69"
- depth 19.5cm/7.68"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 25 sts and 34 rounds
- pattern stitch: 25 sts and 37.5 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body of hat: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Work stockinette stitch in the round, then pattern stitch in the round. Referring to schematic, work evenly spaced decreases as shown. When finished, thread yarn tail through all remaining stitches and cinch top of hat shut.

Finishing: Make pom-pom and crochet leaf; attach to top of hat.

Abbreviations:


ch = (crochet) chain stitch

CO = cast on


st st = stockinette stitch

#-#-# = rounds-stitches-times


Hat schematic




Finishing
