217ss-16 Colorful Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Raffia [100% rayon; 124 yds/113m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
 - color #76 ocean, 1 skein [50g]
 - color #87 turquoise green, 2 skeins [75g]
 - color #92 sun orange, 2 skeins [55g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- large sewing needle
- 1 pair leather purse handles (approx. 30cm/11.81" long)

Finished measurements:

- width 42cm/16.54"
- depth (excluding handle) 30cm/11.81"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• striped single crochet stitch (US): 16 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body (make 2): Work magic ring to begin, then work sc in the round, increasing as indicated. Change colors as indicated in schematic to create wide stripes. See color sequence key.

Finishing: Consider end marked with \Rightarrow the bottom and side marked with \Rightarrow as mouth of bag. Overlap pieces ① and ② and seam together where indicated using half blindstitch. Seam handles to bag where indicated using backstitch.

Abbreviations:

m = magic ring/circle sc = single crochet (US)

Color sequences



Sew handles to body of bag using backstitch.



Overlap bag pieces $\ \ \, \ \ \,$ and $\ \ \,$, then seam together with half blindstitch.
